5	SECTION 1. Th	e following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is autho	rized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	funds which are rec	eived by or otherwise become available to the
8	Pearl River Valley	Water Supply District, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expen	ses of the district for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2	019, and ending June 30, 2020

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of	
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

19	with the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
20	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
21	appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not
22	exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose,
23	unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
24	2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
25	provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
26	Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
27	fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
28	provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
29	agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
30	this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020
31	appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
32	exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
33	the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
34	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
35	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
36	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services"
37	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
38	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
39	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
40	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
41	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
42	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
43	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 55 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 56 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 57 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 59 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete
- 60 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 61 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 62 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 63 Year 2019. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 64 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be
- 65 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 66 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 67 provided during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

SECTION 6. None of the funds appropriated for expenditure under this act may be expended by Pearl River Valley Water Supply District until the district agrees to comply with the following conditions: (1) If any local governmental or nonprofit entity wins the bid for the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major Open, these events shall be exempt from the district's lottery system for host events at the reservoir and given priority of any and all date options available. (2) If any local governmental or nonprofit entity wins the bid for such events, the district shall waive the daily launch fees or any other special event fees for

- 93 the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major Open. (3) The
- 94 Catch A Dream Foundation Bass Classic shall be held on the first
- 95 Sunday in May unless any local governmental or nonprofit entity
- 96 wins the bid for the ESPN Bass Masters Classic or the FLW Major
- 97 Open on that date. The Catch A Dream Foundation Bass Classic
- 98 shall be exempt from the district's lottery system for host events
- 99 at the reservoir and given priority for the first Sunday in May.
- 100 The district shall waive the daily launch fees or any other
- 101 special event fees for the Classic.
- 102 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Two Hundred
- 103 Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is provided for salary increase for
- 104 the purpose of funding overtime, callback or standby pay.
- 105 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 106 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 107 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 108 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 109 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 110 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 111 actions contrary to this provision.
- 112 **SECTION 9.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
- 113 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
- 114 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with
- 115 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.
- 116 **SECTION 10.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 117 and after July 1, 2019.
