HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 69

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF DR.

 FITTEN LAMAR MCMILLIN, JR., AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HIS

 FAMILY, FRIENDS AND COMMUNITY UPON HIS PASSING.
- 4 WHEREAS, it is written in Ecclesiastes 3:1 that "To
- 5 everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under
- 6 the Heaven," and as such, on December 3, 2018, the immaculate
- 7 author and finisher of our soul's destiny summoned the mortal
- 8 presence of dearly beloved, Dr. Fitten Lamar McMillin, Jr., to
- 9 eternal rest, rendering great sorrow and loss to his family,
- 10 friends and community; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the City of Vicksburg lost a wonderful friend and
- 12 community leader with the passing of Dr. McMillin, who was born on
- 13 July 25, 1944, to Dr. Fitten Lamar McMillin, Sr., and Claudia
- 14 Howard McMillin, and there is now a hush in our hearts as we pay
- 15 our respects to the memory of one who has been called to join that
- 16 innumerable heavenly caravan; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Dr. McMillin was a native of Little Rock, Arkansas,
- 18 and a graduate of Sewanee Military Academy, and he received a

- 19 bachelor of arts degree from the University of the South in
- 20 Sewanee, Tennessee, and a master of arts degree from the
- 21 University of Arkansas in Fayetteville, Arkansas; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Dr. McMillin received his medical doctorate from the
- 23 University of Arkansas Medical Center in Little Rock, and he
- 24 completed his post-graduate medical training at the University of
- 25 Minnesota in Minneapolis; and
- 26 WHEREAS, for over 35 years, Dr. McMillin practiced as a
- 27 family physician with River Region Health Systems beginning with
- 28 the Vicksburg Clinic in 1975, and during his tenure, he always
- 29 provided his patients with the utmost care and attention,
- 30 eventually retiring from The Street Clinic; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Dr. McMillin was a licensed Vicksburg National
- 32 Military Park Guide and served on the advisory board for the
- 33 Mississippi Symphony Orchestra and on the planning board for the
- 34 Tercentenary of Fort St. Pierre, and he was a proud and
- 35 contributing member of several Clan MacMillan/McMillin
- 36 organizations; and
- 37 WHEREAS, as a man of outstanding character and incredible
- 38 stature, Dr. McMillin was an active member of The Church of the
- 39 Holy Trinity, the Vicksburg Foundation for Historic Preservation,
- 40 the Lions Club, the Sons of Confederate Veterans, The Heritage
- 41 Guild and numerous other historical and preservation
- 42 organizations; and



43	WHEREAS, Dr. McMillin was truly an exceptional and astute
44	physician, and he always met his patients with respect and
45	graciousness, and though his career was medicine, his passion was
46	history, preservation and architecture, and he was proud of his
47	ancestors and genealogy and was a strong leader in the historic
48	preservation community; and
49	WHEREAS, though he has traversed the river of life to reunite
50	with those who answered God's summons to life eternal and now
51	beckon his arrival to the celestial shores of Heaven's grandeur,
52	the legacy of Dr. McMillin's indelible imprint upon our lives will
53	continue to refresh the hearts and fond memories of his beloved
54	survivors, including his wife, Carol McMillin; three children,
55	Ashley McMillin Moomaw, David McMillin and Stephen McMillin; and a
56	host of other relatives and dear friends; and
57	WHEREAS, we encourage Dr. McMillin's family to find solace
58	from the overwhelming sadness created by the earthly departure of
59	their beloved family member and be renewed in their faith that he
60	fulfilled the purpose of his appointed time in adherence to the
61	commandment of II Timothy 4:7, by having "fought a good fight,
62	finishing his course and keeping the faith until the hour of his
63	departure was at hand"; and
64	WHEREAS, through his medical career, Dr. McMillin was a
65	selfless imparter of hope, life and light, and certainly
66	exemplified the qualities of dedication and professionalism as

well as tremendous devotion to his family and his community,
