1 2 3 4	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2018 OCEAN SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL LADY GREYHOUNDS SOCCER TEAM AND HEAD COACH NEIL SCOTT UPON WINNING THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION CLASS 6A GIRLS SOCCER STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.							
5	WHEREAS, the Ocean Springs High School Lady Greyhounds Soccer							
6	Team finished the 2018 season with their second state title in the							
7	school's history when they reigned victorious at the Mississippi							
8	High School Activities Association (MHSAA) Class 6A Girls Soccer

10	WHEREAS, similar to the nimble, adept and powerful canines							
11	for which they are named, the Lady Greyhounds outpaced and							
12	overcame their opponents during the championship series, slaying							
13	the championship dreams of each of their foes on their way to the							
14	ultimate victory; and							
15	WHEREAS, playing with clear eyes, full hearts and							
16	unimaginable amounts of strength, the Lady Greyhounds Soccer Team

- 22 WHEREAS, as many veterans of the game have said, "defense
- 23 wins championships," this age-old saying defined the immaculate

- 25 fortitude and determination erected a stone wall that helped
- 26 secure each of the playoff wins as well as the championship

- 33 heads held high, and prior to the game winner, Mallory Bellon,
- 34 Makenzie Ezell, Ameris Taylor, Erin Clifford, Kaylee Foster, Loren
- 35 Winters and Kinsley Harmon made good on their penalty kicks; and
- 36 WHEREAS, when the Ocean Springs goalie A'leigh Coleman
- 37 stopped the last shot by Madison Central, the Greyhounds knew that
- 38 this was their chance at victory, so the team put all of their
- 39 hopes and dreams into the foot of their only kicker left, eighth
- 40 grader Jackie Dilorenzo; and
- 41 WHEREAS, the team and onlookers alike waited with bated
- 42 breath as Jackie's ball breezed past the Madison Central goalie to
- 43 make the ultimate contact with the net, and when the final signal
- 44 was made, the tears began to flow, the screams could be heard from

- 45 miles away, the hugs were plentiful and the Ocean Springs High
- 46 School Lady Greyhounds raised their well-deserved trophy high in
- 47 the air and relished in their hard-fought victory; and
- 48 WHEREAS, the 2018 Greyhound team statistics were impressive,
- 49 and there were outstanding headers, strikes, penalty kicks and
- 50 goals by individual players, but the key to this team's consistent
- 51 success has been the constant team atmosphere and year-round hard
- 52 work; and
- 53 WHEREAS, the Greyhounds have been superbly coached and
- 54 inspired by Head Coach Neil Scott, who has broadened their
- 55 knowledge of the game and refined their skills in execution, and
- 56 also helped the players reach their fullest potential on and off
- 57 the field; and
- 58 WHEREAS, Coach Scott continues to build upon the legacy of
- 59 superior play and true sportsmanship forged by the tenacious and
- 60 undaunted spirit of each team member, as evidenced in his ability
- 61 to produce high caliber players and plays and the team's
- 62 successful season; and
- 63 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 64 and commend the superb accomplishments of Mississippi student
- 65 athletes, especially those such as the Ocean Springs High School
- 66 Lady Greyhounds Soccer Team, whose excellence on the pitch and in
