5	WHEREAS, Mrs. Angela McKinnon, a fifth grade teacher at
6	Lewisburg Elementary School in DeSoto County, who has a passion
7	for teaching and a love for children, was awarded the 2018
8	Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science
9	Teaching in recognition of her hard work and unwavering dedication
10	to providing an excellent education to her students; and
11	WHEREAS, Mrs. McKinnon is among the more than 140 teachers
12	nationwide that was honored with this prestigious presidential
13	award for excellence in teaching or mentoring in science,
14	technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) education; and
15	WHEREAS, administered by the National Science Foundation on
16	behalf of the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy,
17	the Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science
18	Teaching are the highest honors bestowed by the United States
19	specifically for K-12 mathematics and science teaching; and

20	WHEREAS, awards are given to mathematics and science teachers
21	from each of the fifty states, the District of Columbia, the
22	Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Department of Defense Education
23	Activity Schools or the United States territories as a group; and
24	WHEREAS, the award recognizes those teachers who develop and
25	implement a high-quality instructional program that is informed by
26	content knowledge and enhances student learning, and since the
27	program's inception, more than 4,700 teachers have been recognized
28	for their contributions in the classroom and to their profession;

30	WHEREAS, awardees serve as models for their colleagues,
31	inspiration to their communities and leaders in the improvement of
32	STEM education, and they receive a certificate signed by the
33	President of the United States, a paid trip to Washington, D.C.,
34	to attend a series of recognition events and professional
35	development opportunities, a \$10,000 award from the National
36	Science Foundation and an opportunity to build lasting
37	partnerships with colleagues across the nation; and
38	WHEREAS, devoted to academic excellence, Mrs. McKinnon earned
39	her bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mississippi
40	College and is certified in elementary education, mild and
41	moderate disabilities, remedial reading K-12 and general science
42	7-12, and she recently completed her master's degree in special
43	education from Arkansas State University; and

44	WHEREAS, as an elementary educator for 26 years, Mrs.
45	McKinnon has spent over 23 years teaching fifth grade mathematics
46	and science in the DeSoto County School District, with the last 12
47	years being at Lewisburg Elementary, and her students have
48	consistently scored 100 percent proficient and advanced on the
49	state science test, a true testament to her exceptional dedication
50	to her students; and
51	WHEREAS, as a mentor to new teachers, Mrs. McKinnon served or
52	the Mississippi Editorial Advisory Board for Macmillan/McGraw-Hill
53	publishers and the content, bias and data review committees for
54	the Mississippi Department of Education to assist in the
55	development of the state test, and she also served as the fifth
56	grade lead science teacher, assisted with the school science fair
57	and judged for other schools in her district; and
58	WHEREAS, as Lewisburg's "Science Guru," Mrs. McKinnon has a
59	tremendous passion for helping her students grow and become
60	productive citizens, and she remains dedicated to her daily
61	mission of teaching her fifth grade class by helping them
62	comprehend the world around them with riveting lessons and
