JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 201

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION TO AMEND CHAPTER 2234, GENERAL LAWS OF
2 2012, TO REVISE THE COMPOSITION OF MISSISSIPPI STATE SENATE
3 DISTRICTS 22 AND 23 AS ESTABLISHED IN JOINT RESOLUTION 201, 2012
4 REGULAR SESSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
6 MISSISSIPPI, That Chapter 2234, General Laws of 2012, which sets
7 forth the composition of Senate Districts 22 and 23 as established
8 in Joint Resolution 201, 2012 Regular Session, are revised as
9 follows:

10 **DISTRICT 22**

11 Bolivar County: Choctaw, Longshot, Northwest Cleveland,
12 Skene and West Cleveland Precincts.

13 Humphreys County: Gooden Lake, Isola, Lake City-2, Louise,
14 Midnight, Putnam, Silver City, Southeast Belzoni and Southwest
15 Belzoni Precincts.

16 Issaquena County: All.

18 Sharkey County: All.



19 Warren County: American Legion Hall, Auditorium, Brunswick,
20 Cedar Grove, Kings, No. 7 Fire Station, St. Aloysius and Vicksburg
21 Junior High School Precincts.

22 Washington County: Arcola City Hall, Darlove Baptist Church,
23 Glen Allan Health Clinic, Hollandale City Hall and Leland Health
24 Department Clinic Precincts.

25 Yazoo County: 3-1 West, 3-2 East, 3-3 Jonestown, 3-4
26 South, * * * District 4 Ward 2, Holly Bluff, Lake City, * * * Lake
27 City-2, Ward 2, Ward 4 * * * and Ward 5 * * * Precincts.

28 **DISTRICT 23**

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That partial or split precincts
40 contained in this resolution are identified in this joint
41 resolution by an asterisk (*) which shall precede its designation
42 within the description of a district.



43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chair and Vice Chair of the
44 Standing Joint Legislative Committee on Reapportionment shall file
45 with the Secretary of State the Split Precinct Block List
46 developed in conjunction with the plan contained in this joint
47 resolution that details the portions of the partial or split
48 precincts that are contained within a district by census tract and
49 block number, and such document duly filed with the Secretary of
50 State is hereby incorporated into and shall be construed to be an
51 integral part of this joint resolution.

52 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the redistricting contained in
53 this resolution shall supersede any prior redistricting for Senate
54 Districts 22 and 23 as established in Chapter 2234, General Laws
55 of 2012, and any prior redistricting for such Senate Districts
56 shall be null and void upon the date this resolution is
57 effectuated.

58 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be placed
59 in the editor's notes that follow Section 5-1-3, Mississippi Code
60 of 1972.
