SENATE BILL NO. 2939

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-15-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO CARRY OVER \$2,000,000.00 IN SPENDING AUTHORITY FROM THE PUBLIC TRUST TIDELANDS FUND INTO THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR ON AN ANNUAL BASIS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 29-15-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 29-15-9. (1) There is created in the State Treasury a
- 10 special fund to be known as the "Public Trust Tidelands Fund."
- 11 The fund shall be administered by the Secretary of State as
- 12 trustee.
- 13 (2) Any funds derived from lease rentals of tidelands and
- 14 submerged lands, except those funds derived from mineral leases,
- 15 or funds previously specifically designated to be applied to other
- 16 agencies, shall be transferred to the special fund. However,
- 17 funds derived from lease rentals may be used to cover the
- 18 administrative cost incurred by the Secretary of State. Any
- 19 remaining funds derived from lease rentals shall be disbursed pro

- 20 rata to the local taxing authorities for the replacement of lost
- 21 ad valorem taxes, if any. Then, any remaining funds shall be
- 22 disbursed to the commission for new and extra programs of
- 23 tidelands management, such as conservation, reclamation,
- 24 preservation, acquisition, education or the enhancement of public
- 25 access to the public trust tidelands or public improvement
- 26 projects as they relate to those lands.
- 27 (3) Any funds that are appropriated as separate line items
- 28 in an appropriation bill for tideland programs or projects
- 29 authorized under this section for political subdivisions or other
- 30 agencies shall be disbursed as provided in this subsection.
- 31 (a) The Department of Marine Resources shall make
- 32 progress payments in installments based on the work completed and
- 33 material used in the performance of a tidelands project only after
- 34 receiving written verification from the political subdivision or
- 35 agency. The political subdivision or agency shall submit
- 36 verification of the work completed or materials in such detail and
- 37 form that the department may require.
- 38 (b) The Department of Marine Resources shall have an
- 39 additional Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in spending
- 40 authority set aside in each fiscal year to cover prior unexpended
- 41 fiscal years project expenses.
- 42 (***c) The Department of Marine Resources shall make
- 43 funds available for the purpose of using such funds as a match or

- 44 leverage for federal or other funds that are available for the
- 45 designated tidelands project.
- 46 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after July 1, 2019.

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
