3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:		
4	SECTION 1. The	e following sum, or so much t	hereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
6	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Dental		
7	Examiners, for the support of said board for the fiscal year		
8	beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020		
9	\$ 1,112,238.00.		
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
11	this act, the following positions are authorized:

17	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's		
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be		
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- 19 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not
- 20 exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose,
- 21 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
- 22 2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
- 23 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
- 24 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
- 25 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
- 26 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
- 27 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
- 28 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020
- 29 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
- 30 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
- 31 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 32 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 33 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 34 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services"
- 35 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 36 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 37 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 38 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Funds are provided herein for all full-time employees to
- 40 receive up to a Three Percent (3%) pay increase to the realignment
- 41 component of the Variable Compensation Plan, excluding head of
- 42 agencies, board members and commission members.

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 44 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 45 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 46 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 47 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 48 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 49 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 50 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 51 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 53 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 54 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 55 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 57 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 58 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 59 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 60 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 61 this act, an amount not to exceed Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars
- 62 (\$27,000.00) shall be allocated to the Mississippi Board of
- 63 Pharmacy to defray the expense of the Mississippi Prescription
- 64 Monitoring Program.
- 65 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 66 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 67 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

- 68 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 69 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 70 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 71 actions contrary to this provision.
- 72 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 73 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 74 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 75 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 76 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 77 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 78 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 79 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 81 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 82 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 83 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 84 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 85 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 86 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 87 and after July 1, 2019.
