SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 627

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND RECOGNIZING MS. PAM
2 CHATMAN FOR CREATING JOBS FOR RESIDENTS IN THE DELTA AND FOR BEING
3 NOMINATED AS ONE OF THE TOP 25 MOST INFLUENTIAL AFRICAN-AMERICAN
4 PEOPLE IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI BY *OUR MISSISSIPPI* MAGAZINE.

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Pam Chatman has partnered with a *Fortune 500*
6 company, FedEx Express, to bring job opportunities to the Delta
7 residents and bus them every day from Cleveland, Mississippi, to
8 Memphis, Tennessee, to work, creating economic growth and
9 self-sufficiency to many; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Chatman has been recognized and honored as one
11 of the Top 25 Most Influential African-Americans in the State of
12 Mississippi and for being a glass ceiling breaker in her community
13 and state by starting her own National and Global Streaming TV
14 Network; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Pam Chatman is a leader and a trailblazer in the
16 State of Mississippi and the Mississippi Delta. For her hard work
17 and dedication of educating women on Women Empowerment and why it
18 is important for them to have a seat at the table, Pam is



19 committed to creating, building and promoting economic
20 opportunities in the Mississippi Delta; and

21 WHEREAS, she has received national recognition by being
22 recognized by Congress and placed in the Congressional Records of
23 history for tireless commitment to make the Mississippi Delta a
24 place of change and opportunity. She was also honored with 12
25 other women from across the United States for her personal and
26 professional achievements at the "Women of Honor 2019" awards
27 event in Atlanta, Georgia; and

28 WHEREAS, in addition to her professional achievements, Ms.
29 Chatman is leading the charge in Mississippi as an Ambassador of
30 Coca-Cola Global Initiative: Coca-Cola 5by20, which is an
31 Empowerment Initiative for women where the headquarters of Coke
32 has validated Boss Lady PChatman as a "Bold Optimistic Successful
33 Sister" (BOSS) Coaching Program an essential to educate, train and
34 network with women from all walks of life in the many resources
35 available to help them become entrepreneurs. She has partnered
36 with a state organization, "Mississippi Family First," to help
37 families across the state to receive direct services that impact
38 the whole family and provide the tools to be self-sufficient. Pam
39 has also formed the organization "Boss Lady Crisis Team"
40 consortium in the Delta, where women from all backgrounds have a
41 seat at the table to discuss ways to assist families in breaking
42 the cycle of poverty and health disparities, and to promote



43 economic growth, family sustainability, mentorship, and leadership

46 the contributions of Ms. Pam Chatman who is an excellent example
47 for all in the State of Mississippi:
