SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 630

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE LEGISLATIVE INTENT THAT  
2 DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME SHALL BE THE YEAR-ROUND STANDARD TIME OF THE  
3 ENTIRE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
5 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN,  
6 That:

7 (1) If the United States Congress amends 15 USC Section  
8 260(a), to authorize states to observe daylight saving time  
9 year-round, it is the intent of the Legislature that daylight  
10 saving time shall be the year-round standard time of the entire  
11 State of Mississippi and all of its political subdivisions.

12 (2) This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the  
13 "Mississippi Daylight Protection Resolution."
