- 7 Basketball Team reigned supreme after finishing the 2018-2019
- 8 season with an impressive record of 25 wins and 6 losses, and
- 9 capturing the 2019 Mississippi High School Activities Association
- 10 Class 3A State Basketball Championship on March 9, 2019, at the
- 11 Mississippi Coliseum, to claim its fifth coveted Golden Ball in
- 12 seven years; and
- 13 WHEREAS, this was truly a dream season, as the unparalleled
- 14 determination and year-round hard work helped catapult the Falcons
- 15 to the number-one spot in Class 3A. Throughout the State District
- 16 and Championship Tournament with a 9-1 record, the Falcons played
- 17 with clear eyes, full hearts and unimaginable amounts of strength.
- 18 In each game, their mental stamina and athletic prowess never
- 19 wavered from the moment they hustled onto the court for the first

- 20 tip off until the final buzzer sounded, as they outlasted,
- 21 outplayed and ultimately overpowered the Holly Springs "Hawks"
- 22 59-44 in the fast-paced, full-court pressed, exhilarating
- 23 Championship Game; and

- 25 are accustomed to playing much larger teams, relied on their swift
- 26 feet, accurate shooting, boxing out executions and strategic
- 27 defensive moves to stop the Hawks' offense and outmaneuver their

- 29 Ball" Trophy back to Velma Jackson after winning its last
- 30 Championship in 2017; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the Falcons kept their focus and played one of their
- 32 best games of the season during the Championship matchup, and the
- 33 2018-2019 MHSAA Class 3A Boys Basketball State Championship Team
- 34 is comprised of the following talented athletes: Mason Riley,
- 35 Jordan Harvey, Leaveon Griffin, RD Wilson, Jarius Young, Charles
- 36 Smith, Joshua Lee, Charlie Jones, Carlton Beamon and Cortez
- 37 Simpson; and
- 38 WHEREAS, with "finishing the job" as the team's adopted
- 39 motto, the Falcons soared to exponential heights on the wings of
- 40 four standout players, several of whom are cousins to the
- 41 Powerhouse Triple Threat Weatherspoon brothers, Quinndary, Nik and
- 42 Brandon, who were the driving forces behind Velma Jackson's first
- 43 string of championships, including: Josh Lee, who contributed a
- 44 game-high 15 points; Jordan Harvey, who netted 12 points and 18

45	rebounds to catapult him to be recognized as the game's Most
46	Valuable Player; Leaveon Griffin, who also added 12 points; and
47	Charlie Jones, who chipped in 11 of the Falcon's points; and
48	WHEREAS, the Velma Jackson High School "Falcons" Boys
49	Basketball Team has been exceptionally coached and tremendously
50	inspired by Head Coach Chris Love, who has broadened the team's
51	knowledge of the game and refined their skills in execution, and
52	he continues to build upon the legacy of superior play and true
53	sportsmanship forged by the tenacious and undaunted spirit of each
54	team member, as evidenced in his ability to produce high-caliber
55	players and plays, and by the team's successful season; and
56	WHEREAS, Coach Love, in his second year at the helm of the
57	winning Falcon dynasty, is also a second-generation basketball
58	coach; he is the son of Lewis Love, Jr., who coached the 1997
59	Canton High School "Tigers" Boys Basketball Team to a Class 4A
60	State Championship and served as Assistant Coach to the 1999
61	Mississippi All-Star Boys Basketball Team, and now with whom

63	permeate the atmosphere of any family gathering; and
