SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 14

1 A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND SENATOR BILLY HUDSON FOR HIS 2 DISTINGUISHED SERVICE IN THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE. 3 WHEREAS, Senator Billy Hudson, R-Hattiesburg, is retiring from the Mississippi Senate after serving 12 years (2008-present); 4 5 and 6 WHEREAS, Senator Billy Hudson is a businessman of integrity 7 and hard work with a complete knowledge of Mississippi's 8 agricultural interests, and there is an acknowledged respect of our esteemed colleague, gentleman and enlightened lawmaker; and 9 10 WHEREAS, Senator Hudson attended The University of Southern 11 Mississippi; he also attended the University of Arizona and Perkinston Junior College in 1957. His professional experience 12 13 includes working as a rancher, and previously serving as the CEO of Hudson Salvage; and 14 WHEREAS, Senator Hudson represents District 45, which 15 16 consists of portions of Forrest and Perry Counties. 18 the Forrest County Supervisors, and his knowledge of local 19 government was extremely beneficial to the Mississippi Senate; and 20 WHEREAS, at the beginning of the 2015 legislative session, 21 Hudson served on the following committees: Agriculture, Chair; 22 County Affairs, Vice Chair; Environmental Protection, Conservation 23 and Water Resources; Finance; Highways and Transportation; Labor; 24 Rules; and Universities and Colleges; and

25 WHEREAS, Senator Hudson and his wife, Barbara, have five 26 children; and

27 WHEREAS, "I have enjoyed being in the Senate and I love 28 public service, but my wife and I have made 571 trips to Jackson 29 and counting over the last 11 years," Senator Hudson said. "I 30 love making a difference. The people of Forrest County have been 31 really good to me, but I am ready to come home and do something 32 locally." Hudson, 80, made the announcement Monday at the Forrest 33 County Board of Supervisors meeting; and

34 WHEREAS, Senator Joey Fillingane, R-Sumrall, said he has 35 enjoyed working with Hudson. "I have been privileged to have 36 served alongside Senator Hudson over the last two terms," 37 Fillingane said. "As Agriculture Chair, he did a great job 38 representing our state's agricultural interest, which is still the 39 No. 1 sector of our economy. That is pertinent to the farmers in 40 our districts and to the entire state"; and

41 WHEREAS, Senator Hudson's service has been marked by his 42 commitment to success and recognized leadership, sound judgment

43 and fairness. He has set the highest standard in all his many 44 roles, as a father, husband, businessman, citizen, statesman and 45 leader in the Mississippi Senate and as a true friend:
