- 5 in the Senate (2004-present); and
- 6 WHEREAS, Senator Buck Clarke is a man of integrity and hard
- 7 work with a complete knowledge of Mississippi's budget-writing
- 8 system, and there is an acknowledged respect of our esteemed
- 9 colleague, gentleman and enlightened lawmaker; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Senator Clarke is a Certified Public Accountant and
- 11 has been a partner of Clarke, Bradley, Baker & Company, LLP since
- 12 1979. Senator Clarke has been uniquely positioned to serve and
- 13 fight for Mississippians. He has served four terms in the

- 14 Mississippi Legislature, 16 years in the Senate, with four years
- 15 as Chairman of Insurance and the last eight years as Chairman of
