THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Mississippi State University, Mississippi University for

SECTION 10. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of
Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, Seven Million
Six Hundred Thirty-three Thousand Dollars (\$7,633,000.00) shall be
available to be expended by the Board of Trustees of State
Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of defraying the
costs associated with the implementation of the Ayers Settlement
as follows:

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall
first use special funds to the greatest extent possible to defray
the costs of providing remediation at the state-supported

SECTION 12. None of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for any purpose that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of the powers or duties of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, or any of the powers or duties of any institution under the jurisdiction of the board of trustees, that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state or federal law, or rules or

regulations that implement state or federal law.

SECTION 13. The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall submit to the Committee on Appropriations of both houses of the Mississippi Legislature by January 1, 2020, a consolidated report for all the several institutions under its jurisdiction, on forms and in a manner to be prescribed by the Legislative Budget Committee, which reflects the anticipated current restricted fund revenues for the 2020 fiscal year, and the budgeted use of such current restricted funds by major object category. For purposes of this section, the term "current restricted funds" shall be defined as those public funds available for financing university operations which are limited by the donor, or by an agency external to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, to specific purposes, programs, departments or schools, but shall not include endowment funds or private gifts exempted under the provisions of Section 27-103-5, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the budget requests of the institutions for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be S. B. 3005

- 151 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 152 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 153 provided during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.
- 154 **SECTION 15.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 155 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning
- 156 continue to review, and eliminate when possible, duplicating
- 157 programs and degrees in the existing institutions of higher
- 158 learning in this state.
- 159 **SECTION 16.** No state appropriations or student tuition and
- 160 fee receipts, except those specifically charged for the provision
- 161 of the services, shall be used to support auxiliary enterprises,
- 162 with the exception of intercollegiate athletics at a level
- 163 designated by the board of trustees. It is the intent of the
- 164 Legislature that auxiliary enterprises shall be self-supporting
- 165 and that deficits not be taken from funds intended for instruction
- 166 and academic programs.
- 167 **SECTION 17.** The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 168 Higher Learning shall report yearly to the Legislature the
- 169 institution compliance with Section 97-11-51, Mississippi Code of
- 170 1972, which prohibits deficit spending.
- 171 **SECTION 18.** Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and
- 172 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be
- in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
- 174 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 175 **SECTION 19.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 176 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

210	SECTION 21. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of
211	Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following
212	amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be allocated
213	to Mississippi State University - Meridian Branch
214	\$ 850,000.00.
215	SECTION 22. It is the intention of the Legislature that
216	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
217	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
218	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
219	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
220	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
221	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
222	made without competitive bids.

SECTION 23. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be allocated to Jackson State University E-Learning Center....\$ 500,000.00.

- 249 **SECTION 29.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 250 of the funds provided herein shall be used to pay certain
- 251 utilities for state-furnished housing for any employees. Such
- 252 utilities shall include electricity, natural gas, butane, propane,
- 253 cable and phone services. Where actual cost cannot be determined,
- 254 the agency shall be required to provide meters to be in compliance

255 with legislative intent. Such state-furnished housing shall 256 include single-family and multifamily residences but shall not 257 include any dormitory residences. Allowances for such utilities 258 shall be prohibited. 259 SECTION 30. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of 260 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following 261 amount shall be allocated to the Delta State University Delta 262 Center for Culture and Learning.....\$ 175,000.00. 263 The funds allocated in this section shall only be used for 264 the Delta Center for Culture and Learning. 265 SECTION 31. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of 266 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following 267 amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be allocated 268 to fund the Washington Center for Internships and Academic 269 Seminars Mississippi Initiative Scholarship Program.......\$ 270 271 This program will provide opportunities for Mississippi's university and college students to gain real-life experience 272 273 working in Washington, D.C. The funding will provide scholarships 274 at Alcorn State University, Delta State University, Jackson State 275 University, Mississippi State University, Mississippi University 276 for Women, Mississippi Valley State University, the University of Mississippi, and the University of Southern Mississippi. A 277 278 written report shall be submitted listing the scholarship recipients by university to the Chairmen and members of the Senate 279

and House Appropriations Committees.

- SECTION 32. None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized
- 282 for expenditure under this act shall be used for research in which
- 283 a human embryo is killed or destroyed.
- 284 **SECTION 33.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 285 of Section 1 of this act, an amount not more than One Hundred
- 286 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to
- 287 implement university system efficiencies, including, but not
- 288 limited to, academic, space, energy and any other system projects
- 289 or expenditures that would lead to improved efficiency. Such
- 290 funds may also be used to draw down other funds or as matching
- 291 funds.
- 292 **SECTION 34.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 293 of Section 1 of this act, Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00)
- 294 shall be used to defray the expenses of the Children's Center for
- 295 Communication and Development at the University of Southern
- 296 Mississippi.
- 297 **SECTION 35.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- 298 act, the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 299 (\$250,000.00) is provided for defraying the expenses of the DuBard
- 300 School.
- 301 **SECTION 36.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 302 of Section 1 of this act, the following sum is for the Southwest
- 303 Mississippi Center Culture and Learning at Alcorn State University
- 304 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending
- 305 June 30, 2020.....\$ 275,000.00.

306 SECTION 37. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 307 act, it is the intention of the Legislature that Nine Hundred 308 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000.00) is provided for the Engineer 309 Research and Development Center in Vicksburg, Mississippi, for 310 Research and Development opportunities in Science and Technology 311 initiatives. 312 SECTION 38. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 313 act, Two Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000.00) is 314 provided for the Delta State University Delta Music Institute. 315 SECTION 39. It is the intention of the Legislature that 316 Mississippi Valley State University is authorized to provide water 317 or sewer service to any existing, privately-owned structures that 318 presently take water or sewer service from Mississippi Valley 319 State University. Furthermore, Mississippi Valley State 320 University is authorized to charge a flat or metered rate for the 321 service provided. Mississippi Valley State University shall not 322 provide any water or sewer service to any new, privately-owned 323 structures. 324 SECTION 40. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 325 of Section 2, the amount of One Million Fifty-three Thousand Five 326 Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$1,053,575.00) shall be derived from 327 unexpended balances in Ayers program funds provided for the 328 purpose in prior-year appropriations enacted by the Mississippi 329 Legislature. These funds are to be allocated as follows: 330 Jackson State University.....\$ 764,427.00 331 Mississippi Valley State University.....\$ 289,140.00

333	SECTION 41. Of the funds herein appropriated, Two Hundred
334	Thirty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$237,000.00) in General Funds and
335	Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) in Special Funds are
336	provided to the Charter School Authorizer Board.
337	SECTION 42. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
338	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
339	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
340	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
341	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
342	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
343	actions contrary to this provision.
344	SECTION 43. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
345	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
346	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
347	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
348	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
349	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
350	SECTION 44. This act shall take effect and be in force from
351	and after July 1, 2019, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2019.
