House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3029

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
7	to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road Construction Fund,
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Office of State
9	Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi Department of
10	Transportation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and
11	ending June 30, 2020\$ 225,353,723.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	this act, the following positions are authorized:

19	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
20	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
21	appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not

- 22 exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose,
- 23 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
- 24 2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
- 25 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
- 26 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
- 27 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
- 28 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
- 29 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
- 30 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020
- 31 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the
- 32 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at
- 33 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 35 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 36 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services"
- 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 41 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 42 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 43 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 55 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 56 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 57 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 58 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
- 59 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Five
- 60 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) is authorized to be
- 61 expended from funds received from the Mississippi Development
- 62 Authority as reimbursements for actual expenses incurred by the
- 63 Office of State Aid Road Construction for administering and
- 64 providing engineering services to political subdivisions as
- 65 authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code of 1972. Any
- 66 such funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads
- 67 Administrative Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019,
- 68 and ending June 30, 2020.
- 69 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
- 70 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Thirty
- 71 Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) is authorized to be expended for
- 72 the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges on
- 73 the Local System Bridge Program (LSBP).

74	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
75	Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete
76	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
77	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
78	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
79	Year 2019. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
80	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be
81	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
82	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
83	provided during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.
84	SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
85	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
86	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
87	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
88	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
89	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

152 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature to 153 authorize the State Aid Engineer to utilize funds available to the 154 Office of State Aid Road Construction, from any source herein 155 appropriated or made available by the counties or any other 156 source, to pay for costs necessary to comply with the National 157 Bridge Inspection Standards and the Federal Highway 158 Administration's requirements for bridge inspections and/or 159 special studies necessary to comply with federal laws. 160 Aid Engineer shall follow the same procedures as have heretofore been established by Sections 65-9-9, 65-9-15 and 65-9-17, 161 Mississippi Code of 1972, for payment of such costs. The Office 162 163 of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and expend these 164 funds subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations of 165 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 166 consistent with the escalation of federal or state funds. 167 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that in 168 the letting of contracts for which the Office of State Aid Road 169 Construction administers and provides engineering services to 170 political subdivisions under the Economic Development Highway Act, 171 bids may be made from the lowest and best bidder after advertising 172 for competitive sealed bids once in a newspaper published or 173 having a circulation in the county or municipality where the contract will be performed, and the date published for the bid 174 175 opening may be not less than seven (7) working days after the 176 advertisement is published.

SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 199 and after July 1, 2019, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2019.
