2	AMEND after line 1/1 by inserting the following as new subsections:
3	"(10) Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, the
4	health education component of the Comprehensive School Health
5	Education Program must include instruction in mental illness and
6	mental health. The Office of Comprehensive School Health
7	Education shall identify the elementary grade level that is most
8	appropriate for incorporating the mental illness and mental health
9	instruction into health education and shall require age-
10	appropriate mental illness and mental health instruction to be
11	included in the curriculum for that grade and all higher grade
12	levels. The mental illness and mental health instruction must be
13	taught during the minimum instructional time required under

14	Section 37-13-134(1) to be dedicated to health education
15	instruction.
16	(11) The mental illness and mental health instruction must
17	include, at a minimum, the following objectives for students:
18	(a) Understanding mental health problems and gaining an
19	awareness of the myths and realities of mental illness;
20	(b) Destigmatizing mental illness and improving
21	attitudes toward seeking help for mental health problems;
22	(c) Recognizing signs and symptoms of mental illness;
23	(d) Employing positive coping techniques to address
24	stress that does not rise to a level requiring professional
25	treatment but if left unattended, may lead to mental illness; and
26	(e) Utilizing professional resources available to
27	students to address mental health issues affecting a student or
28	member of a student's family, including telephone numbers of
29	assistance hotlines and Internet websites of mental health
30	agencies that serve the region in which a school is located."

31 AMEND further the title to conform.
