- 20 **SECTION 3.** Any transfer shall be made in accordance with the
- 21 terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

- 25 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 26 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 27 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be submitted to
- 28 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 29 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 30 during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.

33	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
34	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

36	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
37	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
8 8	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
39	made without competitive bids.

- 90 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 91 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 92 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 93 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 94 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 95 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 96 actions contrary to this provision.
- 97 **SECTION 9.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 100 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 102 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2019, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2019.
