- 81 Community College and funds in the amount of Two Million Six

- 83 (\$2,656,103.00) shall be transferred from the Community and Junior
- 84 College Education Technology Fund for the purpose of defraying the

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- 112 SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that 113 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 114 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 115 116 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 117 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 118 119 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that an amount equal to One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per square foot shall be transferred to the Executive Office of the State Board of Institutions of Higher Learning to defray utility costs.
- SECTION 16. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, Two Hundred Fifty-six Thousand Dollars (\$256,000.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- SECTION 17. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1,

 Thirty-seven Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-six Dollars (\$37,626.00)

 is provided for geospatial site licenses.
- SECTION 18. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally



- or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.
- SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2019, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2019.
