Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1633

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12	SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be

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    offices or at publicly owned facilities.

84	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
85	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this Legislature for
86	the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
87	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
88	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
89	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
90	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
91	made without competitive bids.
92	SECTION 5. None of the funds appropriated under the
93	provisions of this act may be used to pay or reimburse any
94	expenses of out-of-state travel for any member or employee of the
95	House of Representatives without prior approval of the House
96	Management Committee or for any member or employee of the Senate
97	without prior approval of the Senate Rules Committee.
98	SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
99	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
100	to the credit of the joint operations of the House of
101	Representatives and the Senate not otherwise appropriated, for the
102	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020
103	\$50,000.00.
104	SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
105	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
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credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2019.
