Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1644

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance
8	of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the
9	provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
10	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020
11	\$ 9,400,798.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
14	the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Library
15	Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by
16	or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of
17	defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year
18	beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020
19	\$ 3,447,698.00.
20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	this act, the following positions are authorized:

27 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be 28 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not 29 30 exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 31 32 2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 33 34 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 35 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 36 37 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 38 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 39 40 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at 41 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 42 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 43 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services" 44 45 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 46

H. B. 1644 PAGE 2 47 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 48 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

49 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 50 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 51 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 52 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 53 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 54 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 55 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 56 57 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30.

70 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 71 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 72 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds H. B. 1644

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appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2019. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.

80 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 81 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred 82 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the 83 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 84 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

H. B. 1644 PAGE 5 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million Five Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$3,555,779.00) is provided for the cost of health insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public library in Mississippi.

129 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Four 130 Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-four Dollars (\$476,654.00), or so much thereof, shall be derived out of any 131 132 money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section 27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, 133 134 and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, 135 to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Library Commission, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 136 137 Management, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending 138 June 30, 2020.

139 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that 140 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 141 142 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 143 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 144 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 145 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 146 made without competitive bids.

147 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 148 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 149 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency H. B. 1644 PAGE 6 150 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 151 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 152 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 153 actions contrary to this provision.

154 **SECTION 12.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 155 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 156 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 157 158 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 159 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 160 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2019. 161
