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15 Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by 16 or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of 17 defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020..... 18 19 3,447,698.00. 20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, the following positions are authorized: 21 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 22 23 Full Time.... 48 Permanent: 24 Part Time..... 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 25 0 26 Part Time.... 0 27 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be 28 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2021 do not 29 30 exceed Fiscal Year 2020 funds appropriated for that purpose, 31 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2020 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 32 33 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 34 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 35 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 36 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 37 38 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2020 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 39

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40 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at 41 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 42 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 43 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2020 "Personal Services" 44 45 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 46 47 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 48 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

49 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 50 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 51 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 52 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 53 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 54 55 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 56 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 57 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating

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64 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 65 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30.

70 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 71 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 72 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 73 74 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 75 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 2019. 76 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be submitted to 77 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 78 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 79 during the Fiscal Year 2020 budget request process.

80 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 81 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred 82 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the 83 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 84 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

85 SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 86 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 87 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 88 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

117 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 118 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 119 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 120 Committee for Fiscal Year 2021.

121 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that no 122 less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended 123 for the Magnolia Database.

124 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million 125 Five Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-nine 126 Dollars (\$3,555,779.00) is provided for the cost of health 127 insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public 128 library in Mississippi.

129 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Four 130 Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-four Dollars (\$476,654.00), or so much thereof, shall be derived out of any 131 132 money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section 27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, 133 134 and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office, 135 to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Library Commission, 136 acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 137 Management, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020. 138

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139 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that 140 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 141 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 142 143 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 144 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 145 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 146 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

154 **SECTION 12.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 155 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 156 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 157 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 158 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 159 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. This act shall take effect and be in force from 160 SECTION 13. 161 and after July 1, 2019.

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
