- 126 Program during the Fiscal Year 2020.
- 127 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- 128 act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall expend
- 129 such funds as necessary to conduct project planning. Such project
- 130 planning shall apply to all preliminary engineering, right-of-way
- 131 acquisition and construction projects of the department and, at a

 144 for approving a revision;
- (d) Capture the cost of consultants, engineers, attorneys, contract appraisers and other technical and professional contractors used in preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and construction projects.
- SECTION 7. None of the funds appropriated under the
 provisions of Section 1 of this act may be expended by the
 Department of Transportation for construction of new highways if
 such highway segment is less than ten (10) miles in length unless:
 - (a) The explanation and justification for letting such a contract for a length of less than ten (10) miles is entered upon the official minutes of the Transportation Commission;
 - (b) The commission, within ten (10) working days after entry of its explanation and justification upon its minutes, gives notice, by United States First Class Mail, and provides a copy of such entry upon its minutes, to the Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of Representatives and the Chairman of the Mississippi Senate Highways and Transportation Committee.

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- 163 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi
- 164 Department of Transportation, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 165 (\$300,000.00) shall be used for the Statewide Litter Prevention
- 166 Program.
- 167 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 168 Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to expend
- an amount not to exceed Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00)
- 170 received from third-party damages.
- 171 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, not less
- than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) shall be expended for
- 173 contracted maintenance overlay and pavement rehabilitation.
- 174 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 175 Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to expend
- 176 with funds which were obligated in Fiscal Year 2019 for
- 177 maintenance overlay projects and maintenance repair projects but
- 178 not completed by the end of Fiscal Year 2019, in an amount not to
- 179 exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00).
- 180 **SECTION 12.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 181 Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to transfer
- 182 between the various programs in an amount not to exceed ten
- 183 percent (10%) of the amount allocated in Section 3, except that no
- 184 transfers shall be authorized which increase the "Administrative
- 185 and Other Expenses" Program or the "Law Enforcement" Program or
- 186 which decrease the "Maintenance" Program.



- SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
 Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to expend
 funds which were obligated in Fiscal Year 2019 but not expended in
 2019 in the "Capital Outlay-Equipment" category in an amount not
 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) as authorized in HB
 1597, 2018 Regular Session, for Fiscal Year 2020.
- SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
 Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to expend
 an amount not to exceed Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00)
 received from other public or private entities as reimbursements
 for payments made on federal projects.
 - Mississippi Department of Transportation shall notify members of the Mississippi Senate and House of Representatives upon the award of projects within their respective districts and at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public announcement of ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following language: "Funds were made available for this project by the Mississippi State Legislature." Further, the signage shall state the four-year legislative term in which the project was funded.

211	SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that		
212	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the		
213	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things		
214	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,		
215	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind		
216	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to		
217	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are		
218	made without competitive bids.		
219	SECTION 17. The Mississippi Department of Transportation is		
220	authorized to dispose of or transfer used cell phones that are		
221	obsolete or inoperable to cell phone recycling programs dedicated		
222	to providing free phone access to United States military		
223	personnel.		
224	SECTION 18. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance		
225	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of		
226	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized		
227	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the		
228	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,		
229	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

- 322 **SECTION 27.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 323 Mississippi Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to
- 324 pay invoices submitted by Pelco, Chicago, IL for services in prior
- 325 fiscal years in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Seventeen
- 326 Dollars and Thirty-three Cents (\$3,017.33).
- 327 **SECTION 28.** With the funds herein appropriated the
- 328 department may continue and maintain a special compensation plan
- 329 based on experience and training pay increments of five percent
- 330 (5%) for DOT Enforcement Officer V, DOT Enforcement Officer
- 331 Specialist, DOT Enforcement Officer Supervisory and DOT
- 332 Enforcement Officer Commander; and continue and process automatic
- 333 reclassifications and special compensation plans as approved for
- 334 the agency by the State Personnel Board.



SECTION 29. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
SECTION 30. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2019.
