## HOUSE BILL NO. 326

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-29-951, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM ANNUAL GROSS SALES FOR A COTTAGE FOOD 3 OPERATION FROM TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO BE EXEMPT FROM FOOD ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT FEES; TO 5 AUTHORIZE A COTTAGE FOOD OPERATION TO ADVERTISE COTTAGE FOOD 6 PRODUCTS OVER THE INTERNET, INCLUDING THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA; AND 7 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 75-29-951, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 75-29-951. (1) (a) A cottage food operation must comply
- with the applicable requirements of this section but is exempt 12
- 13 from the permitting requirements of Section 41-3-18 if the cottage
- 14 food operation complies with this section and has annual gross
- sales of cottage food products that do not exceed \* \* \* \*Twenty 15
- 16 Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) Thirty-five Thousand Dollars

- 17 (\$35,000.00).
- 18 For purposes of this subsection, a cottage food
- 19 operation's annual gross sales include all sales of cottage food
- 20 products at any location, regardless of the types of products sold

- 21 or the number of persons involved in the operation. A cottage
- 22 food operation must provide the department, upon request, with
- 23 written documentation to verify the operation's annual gross
- 24 sales.
- 25 (2) A cottage food operation may not sell \* \* \*or offer for
- 26 sale cottage food products over the Internet, by mail order, or at
- 27 wholesale or to a retail establishment; however, this does not
- 28 prohibit the advertising of cottage food products over the
- 29 Internet, including through social media. Cottage food products
- 30 are nonpotentially hazardous food products as defined by the
- 31 department.
- 32 (3) A cottage food operation may only sell cottage food
- 33 products which are prepackaged with a label affixed that contains
- 34 the following information:
- 35 (a) The name and address of the cottage food
- 36 operation \* \* \*-;
- 37 (b) The name of the cottage food product  $* * *_{+}$ ;
- 38 (c) The ingredients of the cottage food product, in
- 39 descending order of predominance by weight \* \* \*-;
- 40 (d) The net weight or net volume of the cottage food
- 41 product \* \* \*-;
- 42 (e) Allergen information as specified by federal
- 43 labeling requirements \* \* \*-;

- 44 (f) \* \* \*If any nutritional claim is made, Appropriate
- 45 nutritional information as specified by federal labeling
- 46 requirements, if any nutritional claim is made \* \* \*-; and
- 47 (g) The following statement printed in at least
- 48 ten-point type in a color that provides a clear contrast to the
- 49 background of the label: "Made in a cottage food operation that
- 50 is not subject to Mississippi's food safety regulations."
- 51 (4) This section does not exempt a cottage food operation
- 52 from any federal tax law, rule, regulation, or certificate that
- 53 applies to all cottage food operations.
- 54 (5) (a) The department may investigate any
- 55 complaint \* \* \*which that alleges that a cottage food operation
- 56 has violated an applicable provision of this section or rule
- 57 adopted under this section.
- 58 (b) Only upon receipt of a complaint, the department's
- 59 authorized officer or employee may enter and inspect the premises
- 60 of a cottage food operation to determine compliance with this
- 61 section and department rules. A cottage food operation's refusal
- 62 to permit the department's authorized officer or employee entry to
- 63 the premises or to conduct the inspection is grounds for
- 64 disciplinary action pursuant to Section 41-3-59.
- 65 (6) This section does not apply to a person operating under
- 66 a food permit issued pursuant to Section 41-3-18.
- 67 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 68 and after July 1, 2020.

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ST: Cottage food operation; increase maximum annual gross sales to \$35,000.00 and authorize to advertise over the Internet.
