HOUSE BILL NO. 343

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 73-15-9, 73-15-11 AND 73-15-15,

MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REDUCE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE

3 MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF NURSING BY REMOVING THE PHYSICIAN MEMBER AND

4 THE CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-15-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

7 amended as follows:

8 73-15-9. (1) There is \star \star created a board to be known as

9 the Mississippi Board of Nursing, composed of * * * eleven (11)

10 members, two (2) of whom shall be nurse educators; three (3) of

11 whom shall be registered nurses in clinical practice, two (2) to

12 have as basic nursing preparation an associate degree or diploma

13 and one (1) to have as basic nursing preparation a baccalaureate

14 degree; one (1) of whom shall be a registered nurse at large; one

15 (1) of whom shall be a registered nurse practitioner; and four (4)

of whom shall be licensed practical nurses * * *. There shall be

17 at least one (1) board member from each congressional district in

18 the state * * *.

19	(2) Members of the Mississippi Board of Nursing \star \star \star shall
20	be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the
21	Senate, from lists of nominees submitted by any Mississippi
22	registered nurse organization and/or association chartered by the
23	State of Mississippi whose board of directors is elected by the
24	membership and whose membership includes registered nurses
25	statewide, for the nomination of registered nurses, and by the
26	Mississippi Federation of Licensed Practical Nurses and the
27	Mississippi Licensed Practical Nurses' Association for the
28	nomination of a licensed practical nurse. Nominations submitted
29	by any such registered nurse organization or association to fill
30	vacancies on the board shall be made and voted on by registered
31	nurses only. Each list of nominees shall contain a minimum of
32	three (3) names for each vacancy to be filled. The list of names
33	shall be submitted at least thirty (30) days before the expiration
34	of the term for each position. If such list is not submitted, the
35	Governor is authorized to make an appointment from the group
36	affected and without nominations. Appointments made to fill
37	vacancies for unexpired terms shall be for the duration of such
38	terms and until a successor is duly appointed.

39 (3) Members of the board shall be appointed in staggered 40 terms for four (4) years or until a successor shall be duly 41 qualified. No member may serve more than two (2) consecutive full 42 terms. * * *

- 43 (4) Vacancies occurring by reason of resignation, death or
- 44 otherwise shall be filled by appointment of the Governor upon
- 45 nominations from a list of nominees from the affected group to be
- 46 submitted within not more than thirty (30) days after such a
- 47 vacancy occurs. In the absence of such list, the Governor is
- 48 authorized to fill such vacancy in accordance with the provisions
- 49 for making full-term appointments. All vacancy appointments shall
- 50 be for the unexpired terms.
- 51 (5) Any member may be removed from the board by the Governor
- 52 after a hearing by the board and provided such removal is
- 53 recommended by the executive committee of the affected group.
- SECTION 2. Section 73-15-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 55 amended as follows:
- 56 73-15-11. (1) The members of the Mississippi Board of
- 57 Nursing shall meet annually and organize for the ensuing year by
- 58 election of one (1) of its members as president, one (1) as
- 59 secretary, and one (1) as treasurer. * * *
- 60 (2) The board shall meet at least once every four (4) months
- for the purpose of transacting such business as may come before
- 62 the board. Any member who \star \star does not attend two (2)
- 63 consecutive meetings of the board shall be subject to removal by
- 64 the Governor. The president of the board shall notify the
- 65 Governor in writing when any such member has failed to attend two
- 66 (2) consecutive regular meetings.

- 67 (3) Special meetings of the board may be held on call of the
- 68 president or upon call of any * * * six (6) members. A written
- 69 notice of time, place and purpose of any special meeting shall be
- 70 mailed by the executive director to all members of the board not
- 71 less than ten (10) days before the meeting is held.
- 72 (4) On all matters the board shall function as a board
- 73 of * * * eleven (11) members, and * * * six (6) members, including
- 74 at least three (3) registered nurses and two (2) practical nurses,
- 75 shall constitute a quorum. In any case, the affirmative vote of a
- 76 majority of the members present and participating shall be
- 77 necessary to take action. In all cases pertaining to practical
- 78 nursing, such majority must include the affirmative vote of at
- 79 least one (1) of the practical nurse members of the board.
- 80 (5) The board shall hold not less than two (2) examinations
- 81 each year for registered nurses and not less than two (2) each
- 82 year for licensed practical nurses, at such times and places as
- 83 the board may determine.
- 84 (6) Each member of the board shall receive a per diem
- 85 compensation as provided in Section 25-3-69 for attendance at
- 86 board meetings, together with necessary travel and other expenses
- 87 incurred in the discharge of his or her duties as a board member.
- 88 **SECTION 3.** Section 73-15-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 89 amended as follows:
- 90 73-15-15. (1) Each board member shall be a citizen of the
- 91 United States, a resident of the State of Mississippi, and shall

- 92 before entering upon duties of said office take the oath
- 93 prescribed by Section 268 of the Constitution of the State of
- 94 Mississippi and file same with the office of the secretary of
- 95 state who shall thereupon issue such person so appointed a
- 96 certificate of appointment.
- 97 (2) Each registered nurse board member shall possess these
- 98 additional qualifications:
- 99 (a) Education graduation from an approved educational
- 100 program for the preparation of registered nurses;
- 101 (b) Experience have at least five (5) years of
- 102 nursing experience since graduation;
- 103 (c) Employment have been employed for at least the
- 104 past three (3) years as a registered nurse in Mississippi;
- 105 (d) Licensure be currently registered to practice as
- 106 a registered nurse in the State of Mississippi.
- 107 (3) Each licensed practical nurse board member shall possess
- 108 these additional qualifications:
- 109 (a) Education graduation from an approved educational
- 110 program for the preparation of licensed practical nurses;
- 111 (b) Experience have at least five (5) years of
- 112 nursing experience since graduation;
- 113 (c) Employment have been employed for at least the
- 114 past three (3) years as a licensed practical nurse in Mississippi;
- 115 (d) Licensure be currently registered to practice as
- 116 a licensed practical nurse in the State of Mississippi.
