HOUSE BILL NO. 368

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-555, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI PRISON INDUSTRIES TO PAY WAGES AT THE 3 FEDERAL MINIMUM WAGE RATE TO INMATES WHO ARE USED FOR LABOR; AND 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-555, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 47-5-555. (1) The department shall, subject to the 8 9 necessary security requirements and the needs of the corporation, 10 provide to the corporation sufficient inmate labor for the various prison industry programs. The department may adopt rules and 11 12 regulations as may be necessary to govern the use of inmates by 13 the corporation. The corporation shall establish policies and 14 procedures, subject to the approval of the department, relating to the use of inmates in the prison industry programs. 15 The corporation shall pay wages at the federal minimum 16 (2) 17 wage rate to inmates who are used for labor in the prison industry 18 programs.
