HOUSE BILL NO. 445

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 31-7-38, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
ADD STATE VETERANS NURSING HOMES TO THE AUTHORITY TO OPERATE GROUP
PURCHASING PROGRAMS JOINTLY WITH OTHER PUBLIC ENTITIES; AND FOR
RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. Section 31-7-38, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 8 31-7-38. The board of trustees or governing board of any
- 9 hospital or regional mental health center or state veterans
- 10 nursing home * * * owned and operated separately or jointly by the
- 11 State of Mississippi or any of its branches, agencies, departments
- 12 or subdivisions, or by one or more counties, cities, towns,
- 13 supervisors districts or election districts, or combinations
- 14 thereof, may authorize by resolution the organization and
- 15 operation of, or the participation in, a group purchasing program
- 16 with other hospitals or regional mental health centers or state
- 17 veterans nursing homes, for the purchase of supplies, commodities
- 18 and equipment when it appears to the board of trustees or

19 governing board that such a group purchasing program could or

- 20 would affect economy or efficiency in their operations. Purchases
- 21 by hospitals or regional mental health centers or state veterans
- 22 nursing homes participating in group purchasing programs of
- 23 supplies, commodities and equipment through such programs shall be
- 24 exempt from the provisions of Sections 31-7-9, 31-7-10, 31-7-11,
- $25 \quad 31-7-12 \text{ and } 31-7-13.$
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2020.
