## HOUSE BILL NO. 1147

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-106-79, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE THE FORGIVABLE LOAN UNDER THE TEACHER EDUCATION 3 ALTERNATE ROUTE CERTIFICATION SCHOLARS PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF 4 PRESCRIBING ANNUAL FORGIVABLE LOAN CAPS UNTIL IT REACHES A 5 CAPACITY OF 1,000 RECIPIENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-106-79, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 37-106-79. (1) There is created the Teacher Education 10 Alternate Route Certification Scholars Program to be administered 11 by the Postsecondary Education Financial Assistance Board. 12 Beginning with the 2015-2016 academic year, the program shall provide an annual forgivable loan not to exceed Five Thousand 13 14 Dollars (\$5,000.00) for one (1) of the following alternate route 15 programs: 16 (a) Mississippi Alternate Path to Quality Teachers 17 Training Institute; 18 (b) Teach Mississippi Institute; 19 (c) Career Tech Education (CTE); or

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(d) Masters of Arts in Teaching (MAT).

(2) Qualifying alternate route certification teachereducation scholars must:

(a) Hold a bachelor's degree from a regionally or
nationally accredited institution of higher learning;

(b) Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale on the last sixty (60) credit hours of baccalaureate work, as reported by the graduating institution; and

(c) Meet the Mississippi minimum score requirements for
national exams as required for educator certification as
determined by the State Department of Education.

31 (3) A teacher education alternate route certified scholar 32 who completes the program shall render one (1) year's service as a 33 teacher in a Mississippi public school for each year that the 34 scholar received an award under the program. Repayment and 35 conversion terms shall be the same as outlined in Section 36 37-106-53.

The State Board of Education and the Postsecondary 37 (4) 38 Education Financial Assistance Board shall promulgate such rules 39 as are necessary to administer the Teacher Education Alternate 40 Route Certification Scholars Program and establish necessary eligibility criteria not specifically set forth in this section. 41 Awards granted under the Teacher Education Alternate 42 (5) 43 Route Certification Scholars Program shall be made available to

44 nontraditional licensed teachers showing a documented need for

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45 student loan repayment and employed in those school districts 46 designated by the State Board of Education as a geographical area of the state or in a subject area of the curriculum in which there 47 is a critical shortage of teachers. Repayment and conversion 48 terms shall be the same as outlined in Section 37-106-53 except 49 50 that the maximum annual amount of this repayment should not exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) and the maximum time period for 51 52 repayment shall be no more than four (4) years.

53 \* \* \* Beginning with the 2020-2021 academic year, the (6) 54 number of scholars eligible to receive a forgivable loan authorized under this section shall not exceed two hundred (200). 55 Each year thereafter, for the next four (4) academic years, an 56 57 additional two hundred (200) scholars may be added to the program 58 until the program reaches a maximum capacity of one thousand 59 (1,000) scholars eligible to receive a forgivable loan under the 60 program. Beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year, and each 61 year thereafter, the program shall not award more than one thousand (1,000) scholars with a forgivable loan under this 62 63 program. 64 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

65 and after July 1, 2020.

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
