## HOUSE BILL NO. 1345

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 51-15-108, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW COUNTIES OUTSIDE THE PAT HARRISON WATERWAY DISTRICT TO JOIN THE DISTRICT BY MEETING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS; TO AMEND
- SECTIONS 51-15-103 AND 51-15-107, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH
- 5 INCLUDE PROVISIONS RELATING TO REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTIES WHO
- 6 DESIRE TO JOIN THE PAT HARRISON WATERWAY DISTRICT, TO CONFORM TO 7 THE PRECEDING PROVISIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 10 51-15-108, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 11 51-15-108. (1) A county that is not a part of the Pat
- Harrison Waterway District and is described in subsection (2) of 12
- 13 this section may join the district, with a unanimous resolution
- 14 adopted by the board of supervisors of such county, by filing a
- petition, as provided in Section 51-15-107, in the Chancery Court 15
- 16 of Forrest County, Mississippi, and conforming to the requirements
- as provided in Sections 51-15-103 through 51-15-118. 17
- 18 (2) A county in which the Pascagoula River, Leaf River,
- 19 Chickasawhay River or Tallahala Creek are located, or a county

- 20 having tributaries to such streams or that borders on such
- 21 streams, may join the Pat Harrison Waterway District.
- SECTION 2. Section 51-15-103, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 23 amended as follows:
- 24 51-15-103. (1) The Pat Harrison Waterway Commission
- 25 may \* \* \* be organized in this state in the manner provided for
- 26 under the provisions of this article \* \* \*. This water management
- 27 district shall be an agency of the state and a body politic and
- 28 corporate, and may be composed and is composed of the following
- 29 counties \* \* \*: Clarke, Covington, \* \* \* George, Greene,
- 30 Jackson, \* \* \* Jones, \* \* \* Lauderdale, Newton, Perry, Smith,
- 31 Stone and Wayne.
- 32 (2) A county that desires to be included in the Pat Harrison
- 33 Waterway District, after the original formation of the district,
- 34 may join the district in the manner provided for in Section
- 35 51-15-108.
- 36 **SECTION 3.** Section 51-15-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 37 amended as follows:
- 38 51-15-107. (1) The Pat Harrison Waterway Commission, acting
- 39 through its members who favor bringing the counties they represent
- 40 into the Pat Harrison Waterway District, or other counties having
- 41 Pascagoula River, Leaf River, Chickasawhay River, or Tallahala
- 42 Creek tributaries, shall petition the chancery court of Forrest
- 43 County, Mississippi, to organize and establish the Pat Harrison
- 44 Waterway District, and shall set forth in the petition:

- 45  $(* * *\underline{a})$  The counties to be included in the Pat
- 46 Harrison Waterway District \* \* \*;
- 47 ( \* \* \*b) The necessity and desirability for the
- 48 developments and construction of suitable facilities  $\star$   $\star$   $\star$ ; and
- ( \* \*  $\underline{c}$ ) A general description of the purposes of the
- 50 contemplated works, and a general description of the plan.
- 51 The petition shall be filed with as many copies as there are
- 52 parties defendant.
- The board of water commissioners of the State of Mississippi
- 54 shall be made a party defendant, and the chancery clerk shall
- 55 furnish the board \* \* \* with a copy of the petition with attached
- 56 exhibits. Each county named in the petition shall be joined as a
- 57 party defendant by service of process on the president of the
- 58 board of supervisors \* \* \*, and the chancery clerk shall furnish a
- 59 copy of the petition to each such president. \* \* \* A municipality
- 60 that is located in a county to be included in the district, having
- 61 a population  $\star$   $\star$  of ten thousand (10,000) or more  $\star$   $\star$
- 62 according to the most recent federal decennial census, shall be
- 63 made a party defendant.
- \* \* \* Landowners who are located in the counties to be
- 65 included in \* \* \* the district are not required to be made \* \* \*
- 66 party defendants, or be named in the petition. The chancellor of
- 67 the Chancery Court of Forrest County, Mississippi, shall have
- 68 jurisdiction of the entire waterway district for the purposes of

- 69 this article \* \* \*, and this jurisdiction may be exercised \* \* \*
- 70 in term time or in vacation, as provided in this article.
- 71 (2) A county that desires to be included in the Pat Harrison
- 72 Waterway District, after the original formation of the district,
- 73 may join the district in the manner provided for in Section
- 74 51-15-108.
- 75 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 76 and after July 1, 2020.
