HOUSE BILL NO. 1701 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 2 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL 3 YEAR 2021. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 6 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the 8 9 provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021 10 11 .....\$ 9,109,232.00. 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in 14 the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by 15 16 or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year 17 18 beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021.....

20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21 this act, the following positions are authorized:

27 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 28 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2022 do not 29 30 exceed Fiscal Year 2021 funds appropriated for that purpose unless 31 programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2021 32 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 33 34 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 35 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. Absent a special situation or circumstance approved by the 36 37 State Personnel Board, or unless otherwise authorized by this act, 38 no state agency shall take any action to promote or otherwise 39 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, or 40 realignment. If the State Personnel Board determines a special situation or circumstance exists and approves an action, then the 41 42 agency and the State Personnel Board shall provide a monthly report of each action approved by the State Personnel Board to the 43

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44 chairmen of the Accountability, Efficiency and Transparency 45 Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives and the chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of the Senate and House 46 of Representatives. It shall be the responsibility of the agency 47 48 head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this 49 projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2021 appropriations 50 for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of 51 escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the 52 agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State 53 Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action 54 which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost 55 or the Fiscal Year 2021 "Personal Services" appropriated level, 56 when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the 57 projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be 58 processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the 59 requirements of this provision are met.

60 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 63 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 65 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 68 appropriated level.

H. B. No. 1701 20/HR12/A245SG PAGE 3 (LAR/AM) No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 81 82 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 83 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 84 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 85 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 86 2020. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 87 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be submitted to 88 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 89 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 90 during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request process.

91 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 92 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred 93 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the

130 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that no 131 less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended 132 for the Magnolia Database.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million Six Hundred Sixty-one Thousand One Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$3,661,115.00) is provided for the cost of health insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public library in Mississippi.

138 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 139 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 140 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 141 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 142 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 143 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

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SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

153 SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 154 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 155 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 156 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 157 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 158 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 159 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 160 and after July 1, 2020.
