HOUSE BILL NO. 1733

AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO RANDY BECKHAM, OF 1 2 SIMPSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and 4 5 completely restored to Randy Beckham, of Simpson County, 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction for the crime of forgery on September 29, 1994, for 7 8 which he was sentenced to five (5) years probation. On April 11, 1997, his probation was revoked, and he was sentenced to five (5) 9 10 years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections 11 for the violation. He was also convicted for vehicular manslaughter, and was sentenced on April 11, 1997, to twenty (20) 12 13 years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. 14 He completed all terms and conditions of his sentence and was discharged on December 21, 2008. The Legislature is informed that 15 he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable 16 17 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
