HOUSE BILL NO. 1787

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
2 CORONAVIRUS REIMBURSEMENT RELIEF FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
3 AND ADMINISTRATION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
4 CORONAVIRUS REIMBURSEMENT RELIEF PROGRAM THAT IS ESTABLISHED FOR
5 PURPOSES RELATED TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DUE TO COVID-19;
6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much of it as may be
9 necessary, is appropriated out of any money of the Local
10 Government Coronavirus Reimbursement Relief Fund created in
11 Section 1 of House Bill No. 1781, 2020 Regular Session, to the
12 Department of Finance and Administration for the purposes
13 described in Section 1 of House Bill No. 1781, 2020 Regular
14 Session, for the period beginning upon July 1, 2020 and ending
15 December 30, 2020.....\$ 65,000,000.00.

16 **SECTION 2.** As a condition of receiving and expending the
17 funds appropriated to Department of Finance and Administration
18 under Section 1 of this act, the department shall certify that
19 each expenditure of the funds appropriated to the department under
20 Section 1 of this act is in compliance with the guidelines,



21 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be
22 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the
23 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus Relief
24 Fund established by the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and
25 Economic Security (CARES) Act.

26 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
27 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Local Government
28 Coronavirus Reimbursement Relief Fund not otherwise appropriated,
29 upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State
30 Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed
31 by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided
32 by law.

33 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
34 and after July 1, 2020.
