3 MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION CLASS 4A STATE  
4 FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, the Corinth High School Warriors Football Team and  
6 Head Coach Todd Lowery have completed an amazing 14-1 regular  
7 season and reigned supreme throughout the playoffs to win the  
8 Mississippi High School Activities Association Class 4A State  
9 Football Championship, the school's first football state title;
