8	Mississippi High School Activities Association Class 4A State
9	Football Championship, the school's first football state title;

12	more than just the yearning to succeed, intensely amplified all of
13	their hard work and motivation, which were so apparent throughout
14	the entire season, for the game that ultimately separated the men
