- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-9-105, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
 TO REQUIRE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO GIVE ASSISTANT TEACHERS
 NOTIFICATION OF NONREEMPLOYMENT NO LATER THAN 10 DAYS AFTER THE
 ADOPTION OF THE DISTRICT'S ANNUAL BUDGET BY THE BOARD FOR THE
 FORTHCOMING ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-9-105, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-9-105. If a recommendation is made by the school district
- 10 not to offer an employee a renewal contract for a successive year,
- 11 written notice of the proposed nonreemployment stating the reasons
- 12 for the proposed nonreemployment shall be given no later than the
- 13 following:
- 14 (a) If the employee is a principal, the superintendent,
- 15 without further board action, shall give notice of nonreemployment
- 16 on or before March 1; * * *
- 17 (b) If the employee is a teacher, administrator or
- 18 other professional educator covered under Sections 37-9-101
- 19 through 37-9-113, the superintendent, without further board

- 20 action, shall give written notice of nonreemployment on or before
- 21 April 15 * * * or within ten (10) calendar days after the date
- 22 that the Governor approves the appropriation bill(s) comprising
- 23 the state's education budget for funding K-12, whichever date is
- 24 later * * *; or
- 25 (c) If the employee is an assistant teacher, the
- 26 superintendent, without further board action, shall give written
- 27 notice of nonreemployment on or before June 30 or within ten (10)
- 28 calendar days after the local school board adopts the district's
- 29 annual budget for the forthcoming academic school year, whichever
- 30 date is earlier.
- 31 An interim conservator appointed pursuant to Section
- 32 37-17-6(14)(a) or a school board acting on the recommendation of a
- 33 school district financial advisor appointed pursuant to Section
- 34 37-9-18 shall not be required to comply with the time limitations
- 35 prescribed in this section for recommending the reemployment of
- 36 principals, teachers, administrators or other professional
- 37 educators.
- 38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 39 and after July 1, 2020.
