SENATE BILL NO. 2131 (As Passed the Senate)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE OFFICIAL SEAL USED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CONTAIN THE WORDS "IN GOD WE TRUST" AT THE BOTTOM OF THE SEAL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 7-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 7-3-7. The Secretary of State shall have a seal which shall
- 9 be in the form of a circle, with the image of an eagle in the
- 10 center and around the margin the words "Secretary of State-State
- of Mississippi" and under the image of the eagle the words:
- 12 " * * *In God We Trust."
- 13 The Secretary of State shall affix the seal prescribed to
- 14 every document where the same is required by law, and to every
- 15 certificate and other official paper executed by him where
- 16 necessary or proper. All documents authenticated with * * * the
- 17 seal and signed by * * * the Secretary of State shall be received

- 18 as evidence in all courts, investigations, and proceedings
- 19 authorized by law, and may be recorded in the same manner and with
- 20 like effect as a deed. All copies of papers in the Office
- 21 of \star \star the Secretary of State, certified by him and
- 22 authenticated by * * * the seal, shall be accepted in all matters
- 23 equally in like manner as the original.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** The Office of the Secretary of State shall
- 25 continue to use stationery and other supplies having the seal
- 26 thereon as it existed before July 1, 2020, until such stationery
- 27 and other supplies are depleted. The seal as it existed before
- 28 July 1, 2020, affixed on any public buildings, property or any
- 29 other item shall remain thereon until the replacement of the seal
- 30 due to normal wear or until replacement with any nonpublic funds.
- 31 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after its passage.
