SENATE BILL NO. 2150

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF
WALNUT GROVE, MISSISSIPPI, TO ALLOW THE OPERATION OF LOW-SPEED
VEHICLES AND GOLF CARTS ON CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS WITHIN
THE TOWN OF WALNUT GROVE; TO REQUIRE INDIVIDUALS OPERATING A
LOW-SPEED VEHICLE OR GOLF CART TO HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE
AND PROOF OF INSURANCE; TO REQUIRE LOW-SPEED VEHICLES AND GOLF
CARTS TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE TOWN; TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN TO
CHARGE A REGISTRATION FEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. As used in this act, unless a different meaning
 clearly appears in the context, the following terms shall have the
 following meanings:
- 13 (a) "Town" means the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi.
- 14 (b) "Governing authorities" means the Mayor and Board
 15 of Aldermen of the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi.
- 16 (c) "Golf cart" means any motor vehicle that is
 17 designated and manufactured for operation on a golf course for
 18 sporting or recreational purposes, is not capable of exceeding
 19 speeds of twenty (20) miles per hour, and is equipped with a
- 20 parking brake, headlamps, tail lamps, seat belts and turn signals.

- 21 (d) "Low-speed vehicle" means any four-wheeled electric
- 22 or gasoline-powered vehicle whose top speed is greater than twenty
- 23 (20) miles per hour but not greater than twenty-five (25) miles
- 24 per hour and which is equipped with safety equipment as required
- 25 under 49 CFR 571.500.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** (1) The governing authorities may, in their
- 27 discretion, by ordinance, authorize the operation of low-speed
- 28 vehicles or golf carts only on public roads and streets with a
- 29 speed limit of fifteen (15) miles per hour or less in the Town of
- 30 Walnut Grove, Mississippi. The authorization must be embodied in
- 31 an ordinance and recorded on the minutes of the Board of Aldermen.
- 32 The authorization may be accompanied by conditions not
- 33 inconsistent with this act and may be revoked, in whole or in
- 34 part, by the governing authorities at any time.
- 35 (2) Any person operating a low-speed vehicle or golf cart on
- 36 the public roads and streets in the town under this act must have
- 37 in his or her possession a valid driver's license from this state
- 38 or another state and proof of insurance, and follow the applicable
- 39 requirements of Section 63-15-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 40 **SECTION 3.** (1) Any person operating a low-speed vehicle or
- 41 golf cart as authorized under this act on a public road or street
- 42 shall be required to register the vehicle with the town. The
- 43 owner of the low-speed vehicle or golf cart shall be issued a
- 44 registration decal by the town that must be displayed as
- 45 determined by the town. The registration shall remain valid for

- 46 as long as the registering owner owns the low-speed vehicle or
- 47 golf cart. The operator shall be required to have proof of
- 48 insurance and a valid driver's license in his or her possession at
- 49 all times while operating the low-speed vehicle or golf cart on
- 50 public roads and streets of the state.
- 51 (2) The town may, by ordinance, establish a registration fee
- 52 for low-speed vehicles and golf carts. The registration fee shall
- 53 be retained by the municipal clerk and deposited into the
- 54 municipal general fund.
- 55 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 56 and after its passage.
