## SENATE BILL NO. 2212 (As Sent to Governor)

- 1 AN ACT TO CREATE AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE 2 TRANSPARENCY BY PROMULGATING CRITERIA TO FACILITATE THE
- 3 AVAILABILITY OF COMPARABLE AND UNIFORM COUNTY JAIL CENSUS DATA;
- AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is hereby created an advisory
- 7 committee on jail census data collection to promote criminal
- 8 justice transparency by promulgating criteria to facilitate the
- 9 availability of comparable and uniform data. The duties of the
- 10 advisory committee are as follows:
- 11 (a) Research the standards, format, and terminology
- 12 used by authorities in other states and by the federal government
- to create uniform data-reporting regulations to be used for 13
- 14 recording data on offenders incarcerated in the state's county
- jails and which will capture the following data: 15
- (i) The number of individuals detained for a new 16
- 17 offense or delinquent act.
- (ii) The number of individuals detained pending 18
- trial. 19

- 21 revocation of supervision.
- 22 (iv) The average sentence length for new jail
- 23 sentences by offense type.
- 24 (v) The average sentence length for offenders in
- 25 jail for a probation revocation.
- (vi) The average sentence length for offenders in
- 27 jail for a parole revocation.
- 28 (vii) The percentage of sentences in each category
- 29 offense type, including whether the offense was a violent,
- 30 property, drug, or public order offense. All drug offenses must
- 31 include the type of drug implicated in the offense, as well as
- 32 type of offense, such as possession, sale or manufacture.
- (viii) The average length of stay by offense type.
- 34 (ix) For individuals awaiting trial, the average
- 35 length of stay from the time of arrest to the time of indictment,
- 36 and from the time of indictment to trial.
- 37 (b) Research best practices for implementing a
- 38 centralized database for reporting of the prescribed jail census
- 39 data by each county authority and recommend a timeline for the
- 40 submission of the data.
- 41 (c) Recommend computer equipment and acceptable
- 42 electronic processes for transmission of the data by each county
- 43 to the Administrative Office of Courts.

- 44 (d) The committee shall submit its report to the
- 45 Legislature no later than December 1, 2020.
- 46 (2) The committee shall be composed of five (5) members, as
- 47 follows:
- 48 (a) The Commissioner of Corrections or acting
- 49 Commissioner of Corrections or a designee;
- 50 (b) The State Public Defender or a designee;
- 51 (c) The President of the Mississippi Prosecutors
- 52 Association or a designee;
- 53 (d) The President of the Mississippi Sheriffs'
- 54 Association or a designee; and
- (e) A circuit court judge appointed by the Chief
- 56 Justice of the Supreme Court.
- 57 (3) Appointments must be made within thirty (30) days after
- 58 the effective date of this act. No later than August 15, 2020,
- 59 the committee must meet and organize by selecting from its
- 60 membership a chairman and a vice chairman. The vice chairman
- 61 shall also serve as secretary and is responsible for keeping all
- 62 records of the committee. A majority of the members of the task
- 63 force constitutes a quorum. In the selection of its officers and
- 64 the adoption of rules, resolutions and reports, an affirmative
- 65 vote of a majority of the task force is required. All members
- 66 must be notified in writing of all meetings, and those notices
- 67 shall be mailed at least fifteen (15) days before the date on
- 68 which a meeting is to be held.

- 69 The Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review
- 70 Committee shall provide necessary staff support and the executive
- 71 director shall coordinate the calling of the first meeting of the
- 72 committee.
- 73 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 74 and after its passage.
