SENATE BILL NO. 2304

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 67-1-83, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 ALLOW PACKAGE RETAIL SALES ON SUNDAYS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** Section 67-1-83, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 4 5 amended as follows: 6 67-1-83. (1) It shall be unlawful for any permittee or 7 other person to sell or furnish any alcoholic beverage to any 8 person who is visibly intoxicated, or to any person who is known 9 to habitually drink alcoholic beverages to excess, or to any 10 person who is known to be an habitual user of narcotics or other habit-forming drugs. It shall also be unlawful for the holder of 11 any package retailer's permit to sell any alcoholic beverages 12 13 except by delivery in person to the purchaser at the place of business of the permittee. 14 It shall be unlawful for any permittee or other person 15

to sell or furnish any alcoholic beverage to any person to whom

- 19 department so to do by the husband, wife, father, mother, brother,
- 20 sister, child, or employer of the person. The interdiction in
- 21 those cases shall last until removed by the * * * department, but
- 22 no person shall be held to have violated this subsection unless he
- 23 has been informed by the * * department, by registered letter,
- 24 that it is forbidden to sell to that individual or unless that
- 25 fact is otherwise known to the permittee or other person.
- 26 (3) It shall be unlawful for any holder of a package
- 27 retailer's permit, or any employee or agent thereof, engaged
- 28 solely in the business of package retail sales under this chapter
- 29 to sell or furnish any alcoholic beverage before 10:00 a.m. and
- 30 after 10:00 p.m. or to sell alcoholic beverages on * * * Christmas
- 31 Day.
- 32 (4) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this
- 33 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
- 34 shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars
- 35 (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not
- 36 more than six (6) months, or by both that fine and imprisonment,
- 37 in the discretion of the court. In addition, the * * * department
- 38 shall immediately revoke the permit of any permittee who violates
- 39 the provisions of this section.
- 40 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 41 and after July 1, 2020.
