- 7 **SECTION 1.** For the purpose of directing motorists to the
- 8 Lynyrd Skynyrd Monument in Pike County, Mississippi, the
- 9 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain
- 10 appropriate signs along certain highway segments approaching the
- 11 monument as follows:
- 12 (a) At Exit 8 of Interstate 55, on both the northbound
- 13 and the southbound sides, to indicate the turn onto Mississippi
