1 AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW SECTION IN TITLE 65, CHAPTER 3,
2 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF
3 TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT SIGNS ON INTERSTATE 55 AND MISSISSIPPI
4 HIGHWAY 568 DIRECTING MOTORISTS TO THE LYNYRD SKYNYRD MONUMENT IN
5 PIKE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** For the purpose of directing motorists to the
8 Lynyrd Skynyrd Monument in Pike County, Mississippi, the
9 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain
10 appropriate signs along certain highway segments approaching the
11 monument as follows:

12 (a) At Exit 8 of Interstate 55, on both the northbound
13 and the southbound sides, to indicate the turn onto Mississippi
14 Highway 568; and

15 (b) On Mississippi Highway 568 to indicate the turn
16 onto Easley Road.

17 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified in Title
18 65, Chapter 3, Mississippi Code of 1972.



19 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
20 and after its passage.
