COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL NO. 2723

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE COMMISSION ON WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO EXTEND THE OPEN SEASON ON DEER, WHEN IT ENDS ON A FRIDAY, TO 30 MINUTES AFTER SUNSET ON THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY; TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-31.2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE COMMISSION TO EXTEND THE 5 OPEN SEASONS ON BOBWHITE QUAIL AND WILD TURKEY, WHEN THEY END ON 7 FRIDAY, TO 30 MINUTES AFTER SUNSET ON THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY; TO 8 AMEND SECTION 49-7-31.3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE 9 COMMISSION TO EXTEND THE OPEN SEASONS ON SOUIRREL AND RABBITS, WHEN THEY END ON FRIDAY, TO 30 MINUTES AFTER SUNSET ON THE 10 FOLLOWING SUNDAY; TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-31.4, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 11 12 1972, TO ALLOW THE COMMISSION TO EXTEND THE OPEN SEASON ON FUR-BEARING ANIMALS, INCLUDING ANY ADDITIONAL OPEN SEASON ON RACCOON, WHEN IT ENDS ON A FRIDAY, TO 30 MINUTES AFTER SUNSET ON 14 1.5 THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 17 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 18 amended as follows:
- 19 49-7-31. (1) The open season on deer shall be as follows:
- 20 (a) With bow and arrow: October 1 through the Friday
- 21 prior to Thanksqiving.
- 22 (b) With guns and with dogs: from the Saturday prior
- 23 to Thanksgiving through December 1.

- 24 (c) With primitive weapons and without dogs: December
- 25 2 through December 15.
- 26 (d) With guns and without dogs: December 16 through
- 27 December 23. However, the commission may allow hunting statewide
- 28 or in specific areas with any legal weapon which it may designate
- 29 without dogs after the end of the last season for hunting deer
- 30 with guns and with dogs, but the season with legal designated
- 31 weapons and without dogs shall not extend beyond January 31.
- 32 (e) The commission shall establish an extended season
- 33 with primitive weapons and bow and arrow without dogs from
- 34 February 1 through February 15 for the area south of U.S. Highway
- 35 84 and east of Mississippi Highway 35 only for legal bucks. Any
- 36 antlered deer taken in this area during any open season under this
- 37 section must be a legal buck as defined in this paragraph. For
- 38 purposes of this paragraph, the term "legal buck" means a deer
- 39 with antlers of four (4) points or more with a minimum inside
- 40 spread of ten (10) inches or a minimum main beam length of
- 41 thirteen (13) inches. The commission may regulate the taking of
- 42 deer with antlers of four (4) points or less under this paragraph
- 43 for the proper management of antlered deer. The commission may
- 44 delay the opening date and change the length of bow and arrow
- 45 season in * * * paragraph (a) in this area.
- 46 (f) With guns and with dogs: December 24 through a
- 47 date fixed by the commission that will provide a total of
- 48 thirty-nine (39) days of hunting deer with guns and with dogs when

- added to the number of days provided for hunting deer with guns and with dogs in paragraph (b).
- 51 (g) When the open season on deer ends on a Friday, the
- 52 commission shall have the authority to extend the season until
- 53 thirty (30) minutes after sunset on the following Sunday.
- 54 (2) The commission may set and regulate the deer seasons on 55 wildlife management areas which it administers.
- 56 (3) (a) The commission may allow the harvesting of
- 57 antlerless deer in the districts or zones upon the recommendation
- 58 of the executive director based upon good and substantial
- 59 quantitative data and research evaluations that demonstrate that
- 60 the harvesting is necessary to properly manage the herd.
- 61 (b) The commission, only upon the recommendation of the
- 62 executive director, may allow the harvesting of antlerless deer
- 63 during the deer season with guns and with dogs by a majority vote
- 64 of the commission.
- 65 (c) Nothing in this subsection prohibits the harvesting
- of either-sex deer by landowners or leaseholders on private lands
- 67 under the deer management assistance program prescribed or
- 68 approved by the executive director.
- 69 (4) The commission may provide a special permit for the
- 70 harvesting of deer when they are depredating and destroying crops.
- 71 The department shall supervise the harvesting and provide for the
- 72 salvaging of the meat of the animals. The commission may
- 73 authorize the department to assist any farmer in this state, who

- 74 sustains crop damage by wildlife, in eradication of the problem
- 75 wildlife.
- 76 (5) (a) During any open season on deer with primitive
- 77 weapons after November 30, a person may use any legal weapon of
- 78 choice on private lands only, if the person is:
- 79 (i) The title owner of the land;
- 80 (ii) The lessee of the hunting rights on the land;
- 81 (iii) A member of a hunting club leasing the
- 82 hunting rights on the land; or
- (iv) A guest of a person specified in subparagraph
- 84 (i), (ii) or (iii).
- 85 (b) If the person is required to have a hunting
- 86 license, the person must have a primitive weapon license,
- 87 Sportsman's License or a Lifetime Sportsman's License.
- 88 **SECTION 2.** Section 49-7-31.2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 89 amended as follows:
- 90 49-7-31.2. The open season for game birds shall be as
- 91 follows:
- 92 (a) On bobwhite quail: The season shall open on
- 93 Thanksgiving Day and run through the first Saturday in March next
- 94 following. When the open season ends on a Friday, the commission
- 95 shall have the authority to extend the season until thirty (30)
- 96 minutes after sunset on the following Sunday.
- 97 (b) On pheasant: There shall be no open season on

- 101 may fix special fall either-sex seasons. When the open season
- 102 ends on a Friday, the commission shall have the authority to
- 103 extend the season until thirty (30) minutes after sunset on the
- 104 <u>following Sunday.</u>
- 105 (d) On migratory birds: The open season for migratory
- 106 birds shall be the season prescribed by the Federal Migratory Bird
- 107 Treaty regulations.
- 108 **SECTION 3.** Section 49-7-31.3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 109 amended as follows:
- 110 49-7-31.3. The open season on game animals except deer shall
- 111 be as follows:
- 112 (a) On squirrel: The season shall open on October 1
- 113 and run through February 28 next following. In addition, the
- 114 commission is authorized to set a season that shall open not
- 115 earlier than May 15 and run not later than June 1 next following.
- 116 When the open season ends on a Friday, the commission shall have
- 117 the authority to extend the season until thirty (30) minutes after
- 118 sunset on the following Sunday.
- 119 (b) On rabbits: The season shall open on the Saturday
- 120 nearest October 15 and run through February 28 next following, and
- 121 when rabbits are depredating or destroying crops, the owner of the
- 122 crops or his tenants may shoot the rabbits with guns. When the
- 123 open season ends on a Friday, the commission shall have the

124	authority	to	extend	the	season	until	thirty	(30) minutes	after

- 125 sunset on the following Sunday.
- 126 **SECTION 4.** Section 49-7-31.4, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 127 amended as follows:
- 128 49-7-31.4. (1) The commission may fix the open season on
- 129 fur-bearing animals between November 1 and March 1 next following
- 130 and fix the open season for hunting opossums, raccoons and bobcats
- 131 with dogs and guns by licensed hunters from October 1 to February
- 132 28 next following; but raccoons and bobcats may be run, hunted,
- 133 chased or pursued throughout the year with dogs by licensed
- 134 hunters.
- 135 (2) The commission may establish an additional open season
- 136 on raccoon from July 1 through October 1, and the bag limit on
- 137 raccoon during the additional open season shall be one (1) per
- 138 party, per night.
- 139 (3) When the open season on fur-bearing animals, including
- 140 any additional open season on raccoon, ends on a Friday, the
- 141 commission shall have the authority to extend the season until
- 142 thirty (30) minutes after sunset on the following Sunday.
- 143 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 144 and after July 1, 2020.
