- (4) If any state employee is unable to receive the full amount of the salary increase provided for in this section because to award the entire allowable increase would cause that employee's base salary to exceed the end step of his or her particular job classification, the State Personnel Board shall amend the Variable Compensation Plan by increasing the end step of that particular job classification. The increase shall be in an amount necessary to enable all employees in that particular job classification to be eligible to receive the full salary increase to which they are entitled under this section.
- 36 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Legislature shall appropriate the funds 37 necessary to provide for the increases in compensation provided 38 for in this act.
- 39 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 40 and after July 1, 2020.
