SENATE BILL NO. 3034

AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DEXTER FOSTER OF LEE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Dexter Foster of Lee County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction
- 7 of the crime of strong armed robbery in 2003 in Lee County,
- 8 Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve ten (10) years in the
- 9 custody of the Department of Corrections. His sentence was
- 10 suspended and he was placed on probation for five (5) years. He
- 11 violated probation and his probation was revoked; he was sentenced
- 12 on May 20, 2004, in Lee County Circuit Court to serve a term of
- 13 two (2) years followed by three (3) years' probation. Dexter
- 14 Foster was released on May 6, 2005, and his probation was
- 15 terminated on August 1, 2008. Since that time, he has conducted
- 16 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 17 lawful manner.
