- 31 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., is an indomitable

- 34 transforming lives and positively impacting communities through
- 35 established international programs that are innovative, socially
- 36 relevant and measurable; and

- 38 International President of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., and
- 39 Mitzi Dease Paige, Esquire, serves as the 26th South Eastern

- 42 consists of more than 11,000 members in 108 chapters that work
- 43 independently and collectively to embrace and implement the
