SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 581

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION
3 AND PASSAGE OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7,
4 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DESIGNATE JUNE 19TH AS AN OFFICIAL
5 STATE HOLIDAY IN RECOGNITION OF JUNETEENTH, COMMEMORATING THE END
6 OF SLAVERY IN THE UNITED STATES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
8 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That Joint Rule 40 of
9 the Senate and the House is hereby suspended for the purpose of
10 requesting the drafting, introduction, consideration and passage,
11 regardless of any deadlines imposed by said rule, of a bill
12 entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
13 TO DESIGNATE JUNE 19TH AS AN OFFICIAL STATE HOLIDAY IN RECOGNITION
14 OF JUNETEENTH, COMMEMORATING THE END OF SLAVERY IN THE UNITED
15 STATES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
