- 7 Artiste; and
- 8 WHEREAS, voted Jackson Free Press Best of Jackson 2020: Best
- 9 Chef, featured on the list of "Best Chefs America" in 2013 and
- 10 2017, Nick has appeared in the pages of Southern Living and on
- 11 "Comfort Nation" Season 2, was honored to be Mississippi's first
- 12 Food Network's "Chopped" Champion, Alton's Challenge and featured
- 13 on Food Network's Cutthroat Kitchen; and
- 14 WHEREAS, born and raised in Edwards, Mississippi, Wallace
- 15 possesses the creativity, innovation and drive to deliver
- 16 exceptional cuisine of the highest quality, redefining the
- 17 Southern food experience by blending his family-farm origins with
- 18 sophisticated French techniques to create exceptional dining

- 19 experiences, and crediting his grandmothers, Queen Morris and
- 20 Lennel Donald, for nurturing his innate talent for culinary arts
- 21 perfection; and
- 22 WHEREAS, with a desire to take on any challenge the culinary
- 23 world has to offer, Wallace's drive to deliver exceptional cuisine
- 24 of the highest quality reflects his culinary philosophy and
- 25 passion, which trend towards a healthier lifestyle by working with
- 26 local farmers to create unique farm-to-table dining experiences
- 27 that are exceptionally pleasing to the palate; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Nick has served as Chef for some of the largest and
- 29 most prominent museums and hotels in the State of Mississippi,
- 30 including the Mississippi Museum of Art, Marriott Hotels, and the
- 31 historic King Edward Hotel. Chef Wallace, through these
- 32 positions, has been able to hone his leadership skills and push
- 33 the limits for continuous and flourishing innovation; and
- 34 WHEREAS, currently Founder and Executive Chef of Nick Wallace
- 35 Culinary, and Nick Wallace Catering and Creativity Kitchen, Chef
- 36 Wallace has moved his culinary talent and innovative methods into
- 37 Jackson Public Schools through his nonprofit organization,
- 38 Creativity Kitchen, enabling him to work closely with the chefs in
- 39 the Jackson Public Schools to provide better tasting and healthier
- 40 food for scholars; and
- WHEREAS, in November 2019, Creativity Kitchen partnered with
- 42 Whole Foods 5% Community Giving Program and put the money back

- 43 into the community by donating a certain percentage of it to one
- 44 of the local elementary schools; and
- WHEREAS, a five-time presenter for the James Beard
- 46 Foundation, Nick's "Southern Hospitality" dinners hosted in New
- 47 York demonstrate the expanse of his culinary knowledge of flavor
- 48 and technique, which can be experienced in three restaurants in
- 49 Natchez, Mississippi, and through Crooked Coffee retail branded
- 50 coffee; and
- 51 WHEREAS, Nick has participated in Flavored Nation's 2019 50
- 52 States 50 Chefs in Chattanooga, Tennessee, and is a rare talent
- 53 of exceptional caliber, whose gift can soon be witnessed on a
- 54 Canadian food television show slated to air in 2020; and
- 55 WHEREAS, Chef Wallace, who has also formed a partnership with
- 56 Mississippi's own first female Iron Chef Cat Cora, continues to
- 57 perform community outreach by forging partnerships with such
- 58 organizations as: the American Cancer Society, which recognized
- 59 him as one of the 2019 Real Men Wear Pink; Share the Gulf, which
- 60 named him co-chair; and the Partnership for a Healthy Mississippi;

- 62 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize and commend
- 63 the remarkable talent of Chef Wallace, whose mastery of his craft
- 64 has bestowed renowned national acclaim upon himself, his community
- 65 and the State of Mississippi:
