13 parents to achieve academic excellence and develop clear missions,  
14 high curriculum standards, and performance goals; and

16 least recognized individuals in education; and

18 principals deserve a month of recognition here in Mississippi to  
19 honor these unsung heroes for their tireless efforts in pursuit of

21           WHEREAS, the celebration of National Principals Month honors  
22 principals in elementary, middle, and high schools across America,  
23 and it recognizes the significant role that they have in molding  
24 students into bright and successful future leaders:

25           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
26 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
