House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2125

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 12 **SECTION 1.** Section 35-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 13 amended as follows:
- 14 35-3-13. (1) All chancery clerks, of all counties of the
- 15 State of Mississippi, shall record, without any cost whatsoever to
- 16 any person of the Armed Forces of the United States residing in
- 17 the same county as the chancery clerk, all honorable discharges
- 18 and all certificates of service of any and all members of the
- 19 Armed Forces of the United States of America who have served in
- 20 the Armed Forces of the United States, including the army, navy
- 21 and marine, coast guard and nurses corps.
- 22 (2) The board of supervisors of all counties shall furnish
- 23 to the chancery clerk all necessary supplies and equipment for the
- 24 recording of these instruments, and allow out of the general fund
- of the county the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for recording the
- 26 discharge certificate. All certified copies will be furnished
- 27 free without cost either to the soldier, sailor, marine, coast
- 28 quardsman, nurse or the county.

29 The chancery clerk of all counties shall keep a record 30 of all honorable discharges and certificates of discharge in a separate record safequarded and protected from theft, and 31 32 definitely marked "Record of Discharged Members of the Armed 33 Forces." The chancery clerk shall furnish certified copies of the 34 discharge or discharge certificate of any veteran when so requested by the veteran, his dependents or his authorized 35 representative; however, before furnishing any copy of the 36 37 discharge or discharge certificate, the chancery clerk must verify the identity and relationship to the veteran of the person 38 39 requesting the copy and must obtain and maintain on file a signed consent for the release of information from the veteran, dependent 40 41 or authorized representative. 42 The chancery clerk of all counties shall keep a 43 record of all veterans Form DD-214 in a separate record

safeguarded and protected from theft, and marked "Record of

Veterans Service Form DD-214 Members of the Armed Forces." The
chancery clerk shall record the form without charge and shall
furnish certified copies of the Form DD-214 without charge when so

representative. The Form DD-214 record is not a public record
under the public records law, and before furnishing any copy of
the form, the chancery clerk shall verify the identity and
relationship to the veteran of the person requesting the copy and
obtain and maintain in the file a signed consent for the release
of information from the veteran, dependent or authorized

- 56 form for use by the veteran, dependent or authorized
- 57 representative to provide such consent for the release of
- 58 information from the veteran, dependent or authorized
- 59 representative.
- (b) The chancery clerk of all counties shall keep a
- 61 record of all veterans Form NGB-22 in a separate record
- 62 safeguarded and protected from theft, and marked "Record of
- 63 Veterans Service Form NGB-22 Members of the Armed Forces." The
- 64 chancery clerk shall record the form without charge and shall
- 65 furnish certified copies of the Form NGB-22 without charge when so
- 66 requested by the veteran, his dependents or his authorized
- 67 representative. The Form NGB-22 record is not a public record
- 68 under the public records law, and before furnishing any copy of
- 69 the form, the chancery clerk shall verify the identity and
- 70 relationship to the veteran of the person requesting the copy and
- 71 obtain and maintain in the file a signed consent for the release
- 72 of information from the veteran, dependent or authorized
- 73 representative. The chancery clerk shall prepare and provide a
- 74 form for use by the veteran, dependent or authorized
- 75 representative to provide such consent for the release of
- 76 information from the veteran, dependent or authorized
- 77 representative.
- 78 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after July 1, 2020.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 35-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE RECORDATION WITHOUT CHARGE OF ANY VETERANS FORM DD-214 WITH THE CHANCERY CLERK, TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH FORM IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD AND TO AUTHORIZE COPIES TO BE MADE ONLY ON THE REQUEST OF THE VETERAN OR HIS IMMEDIATE FAMILY; TO AUTHORIZE THE RECORDATION WITHOUT CHARGE OF ANY VETERANS FORM NGB-22 WITH THE CHANCERY CLERK, TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH FORM IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD AND TO AUTHORIZE COPIES TO BE MADE ONLY ON THE REQUEST OF THE

9 VETERAN, A DEPENDENT OR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE; AND FOR RELATED

10 PURPOSES.
