House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2940

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs
8	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending
9	June 30, 2021\$ 5,748,748.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
12	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs
13	Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
14	otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance
15	of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and
16	ending June 30, 2021\$ 39,948,076.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	this act, the following positions are authorized:
19	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
20	Permanent: Full Time
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With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 24 25 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be 26 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2022 do not 27 exceed Fiscal Year 2021 funds appropriated for that purpose, 28 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 29 2021 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 30 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 31 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 32 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 33 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 34 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2021 35 36 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 37 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 38 39 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 41 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2021 "Personal Services" 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 43 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 44 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 45

S. B. 2940 PAGE 2 46 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 48 49 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 51 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 52 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 54 appropriated level.

55 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

59 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in 60 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating 61 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 62 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

63 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 64 Sections 1 and 2, funds in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty 65 Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of 66 providing care to indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the 67 nonveteran surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse was a resident of a state veterans home at the 68 69 time of the veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's 70 death, meets the indigent/low-income criteria established by the 71 State Veterans Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. the intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a current surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section and its provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997."

78 SECTION 5. The Veterans Affairs Board shall have continued 79 authority for all action related to planning, development, 80 construction, and outfitting of the North Mississippi Veterans' 81 Memorial Cemetery.

82 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Veterans Affairs Board shall maintain complete accounting and 83 84 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 85 appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of details as 86 87 maintained for Fiscal Year 2020. It is further the intention of 88 the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 89 90 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 91 provided during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request process.

92 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that 93 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 94 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 95 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 96 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 97 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to S. B. 2940 PAGE 4 98 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 99 made without competitive bids.

100 **SECTION 8.** The Veterans Affairs Board shall have the 101 authority to escalate and expend increased federal funds obtained 102 by virtue of Public Law 109-461 (38 CFR Part 51).

103 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 104 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 105 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 106 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 107 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 108 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. This act shall take effect and be in force from 109 SECTION 10. 110 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed from and after 111 June 30, 2020.
