House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2962

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

18	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's		
19	responsibility to make certain that funds required to be

22 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 23 2021 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 24 25 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 26 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 27 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 28 29 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2021 30 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. 31 If, at 32 the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 33 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 34 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2021 "Personal Services" 35 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 36 37 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 38 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 39

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

S. B. 2962 PAGE 2 47 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 48 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

53 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in 54 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating 55 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 56 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

57 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in this act, it is the intention of the Legislature that the State Board of Contractors 58 may expend funds not to exceed Two Million Three Hundred Thousand 59 60 Dollars (\$2,300,000.00) for the purpose of defraying the cost of (1) enforcement as set forth in Section 31-3-21, Mississippi Code 61 62 of 1972, (2) enlisting of any private collection firm(s) to locate 63 and collect any uncollected fines, and (3) administrative costs 64 associated with collections. Any funds spent for this purpose 65 shall be subject to a performance audit if requested by the 66 Appropriations Chairmen in either the House or Senate.

67 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 68 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 69 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 70 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 71 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 72 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to S. B. 2962 PAGE 3 73 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 74 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

89 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed from and after 90 June 30, 2020.
