- 20 the Armed Forces of the United States, including the army, navy
- 21 and marine, coast guard and nurses corps.



- 22 The board of supervisors of all counties shall furnish 23 to the chancery clerk all necessary supplies and equipment for the 24 recording of these instruments, and allow out of the general fund 25 of the county the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for recording the 26 discharge certificate. All certified copies will be furnished 27 free without cost either to the soldier, sailor, marine, coast quardsman, nurse or the county. 28 29 The chancery clerk of all counties shall keep a record (3)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 35-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 AUTHORIZE THE RECORDATION WITHOUT CHARGE OF ANY VETERANS FORM 3 DD-214 WITH THE CHANCERY CLERK, TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH FORM IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD AND TO AUTHORIZE COPIES TO BE MADE ONLY ON THE 5 REQUEST OF THE VETERAN OR HIS IMMEDIATE FAMILY; TO AUTHORIZE THE RECORDATION WITHOUT CHARGE OF ANY VETERANS FORM NGB-22 WITH THE 7 CHANCERY CLERK, TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH FORM IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD 8 AND TO AUTHORIZE COPIES TO BE MADE ONLY ON THE REQUEST OF THE 9 VETERAN, A DEPENDENT OR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE; AND FOR RELATED 10 PURPOSES.
